Parks & Recreation Advisory Board Vacancies

The Martin County Board of County Commissioners is seeking applications from individuals interested in being considered for appointment to fill vacancies on the **Parks and Recreation Advisory Board**. All individuals serve without compensation and are requested to submit an Application for Appointment to Martin County Administration **by Friday, January 2, 2026**. It shall be the function of the Board to advise the Board of County Commissioners on the planning and implementation of the Parks and Recreation Master Plan and to make recommendations on programs, services, acquisition and uses of parkland, sports, and recreation facilities as well as such other duties as may be assigned by the Board of County Commissioners.

Members who miss more than 50 percent of regularly scheduled or three consecutive meetings in a given calendar year will be automatically removed from the Board.

VACANT POSITION – Two At-large members who must be Martin County residents and shall not be employed by the County nor be related to a County employee or have a business relationship with Parks and Recreation vendors. These are two-year terms.

Florida law prohibits an advisory board member from doing business with its agency (the County). Section 112.313(3) and (7), Fla. Stat.

Meetings are generally held on the third Thursday of each month at 4:30 pm. The next few meetings are scheduled for January 15, February 19, March 19, April 16, May 21, and June 18 and are held at the Administration Building (2401 SE Monterey Road, Stuart).
