A Proclamation

**Recognizing National Mosquito Control Awareness Week
in Martin County, Florida**

Whereas, mosquitoes are not only a nuisance that diminishes enjoyment of outdoor spaces and activities, but they also pose a serious public health risk as vectors of diseases such as West Nile virus, dengue, Zika and other mosquito-borne illnesses; and

Whereas, proactive mosquito control and community awareness efforts help protect public health, enhance quality of life, support outdoor recreation and tourism, and contribute to a healthier, more comfortable environment for all; and

Whereas, Martin County recognizes the valuable work of public health professionals, mosquito control specialists, community partners and volunteers engaged in reducing mosquito habitat, educating the public and applying safe, science-based mosquito control methods; and

Whereas, Martin County supports efforts to improve community resilience against mosquito-borne disease and promote public education on effective mosquito control practices.

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that June 21-27, 2026 shall be known as National Mosquito Control Awareness Week in Martin County. Further, the Board expresses appreciation to all members of this important industry for their contributions.
