A Proclamation

Declaring The Faith Foundation Day in Martin County, Florida

Whereas, the foundation has made a measurable impact through service projects including a Stuart Beach cleanup, handwritten encouragement cards for children at Palm Beach Children’s Hospital and a hygiene product drive that collected over 600 essential items for Place of Hope of the Treasure Coast; and

Whereas, The Faith Foundation continues to expand its outreach through upcoming service initiatives with the Humane Society of the Treasure Coast and an active fundraiser supporting the Make-A-Wish Foundation to benefit children battling critical illnesses; and

Whereas, these student-led efforts reflect the values of kindness, hope, generosity and responsibility, uniting young people from diverse backgrounds around a shared mission of faith and community care; and

Whereas, the foundation exemplifies the strength of youth vision, volunteerism and collaboration, inspiring a culture of purpose and compassion across Martin County.

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that July 18, 2025 shall be known as “The Faith Foundation Day” in Martin County, in honor of the organization’s devotion to youth-led service, spiritual empowerment and transformative local impact.
