Hello Mr. Chairman,

Thank you for your continued attention to the county's puppy-selling pet store issue. I wrote to you a couple weeks ago urging you to keep the humane pet store ordinance intact, and I'm following up today with new information demonstrating just how important it is to stand by the vote you took in June.

Puppy Mills: Since the ordinance was enacted, we've received significantly more public records connecting Martin County's two puppy stores to large-scale, Midwest puppy mills—some with terrible animal welfare records. Stopping these stores from trucking in puppies from cruel puppy mills to sell to

unsuspecting consumers is a key aspect of the humane pet store ordinance. See [here](#) for details on local stores' puppy mill connection.

Mr. Goessel's criminal record: According to 19th Judicial Circuit of Florida (Martin County) court documents, Wags About You owner, Ryan Goessel, is on probation for "criminal use of personal I.D. information" and "offering an animal for sale without proper health requirements." He was arrested and charged after a customer reported a fraudulent health certificate to the FL Dept. of Agriculture. (The veterinarian on the health certificate claimed to have never seen the cat.) Last month, Goessel was ordered not to sell animals out of his home, to discontinue the corporate sale of animals by the end of 2022, with the court noting he could retain ownership of Wags About You, and to make restitution to the victim in the amount of \$1400. Ms. Scott's history of violations: The owner of The Noble Paw, Jill Scott, has a history of violations for selling puppies in violation of Palm Beach County law from Petlife—the animal hospital she owns. In 2020, Palm Beach County Animal Care and Control cited her for selling puppies without the required permit and failing to provide required data to the county, after health certificates were obtained showing the animal hospital obtained the puppies from an Ohio puppy broker. She received similar citations in 2017. The problems noted above stem from the sale of puppies, and we are happy to be a resource for the stores as they transition to a business model focused on pet products and services—a model that can also be lucrative for these store owners if they decide to embrace it.

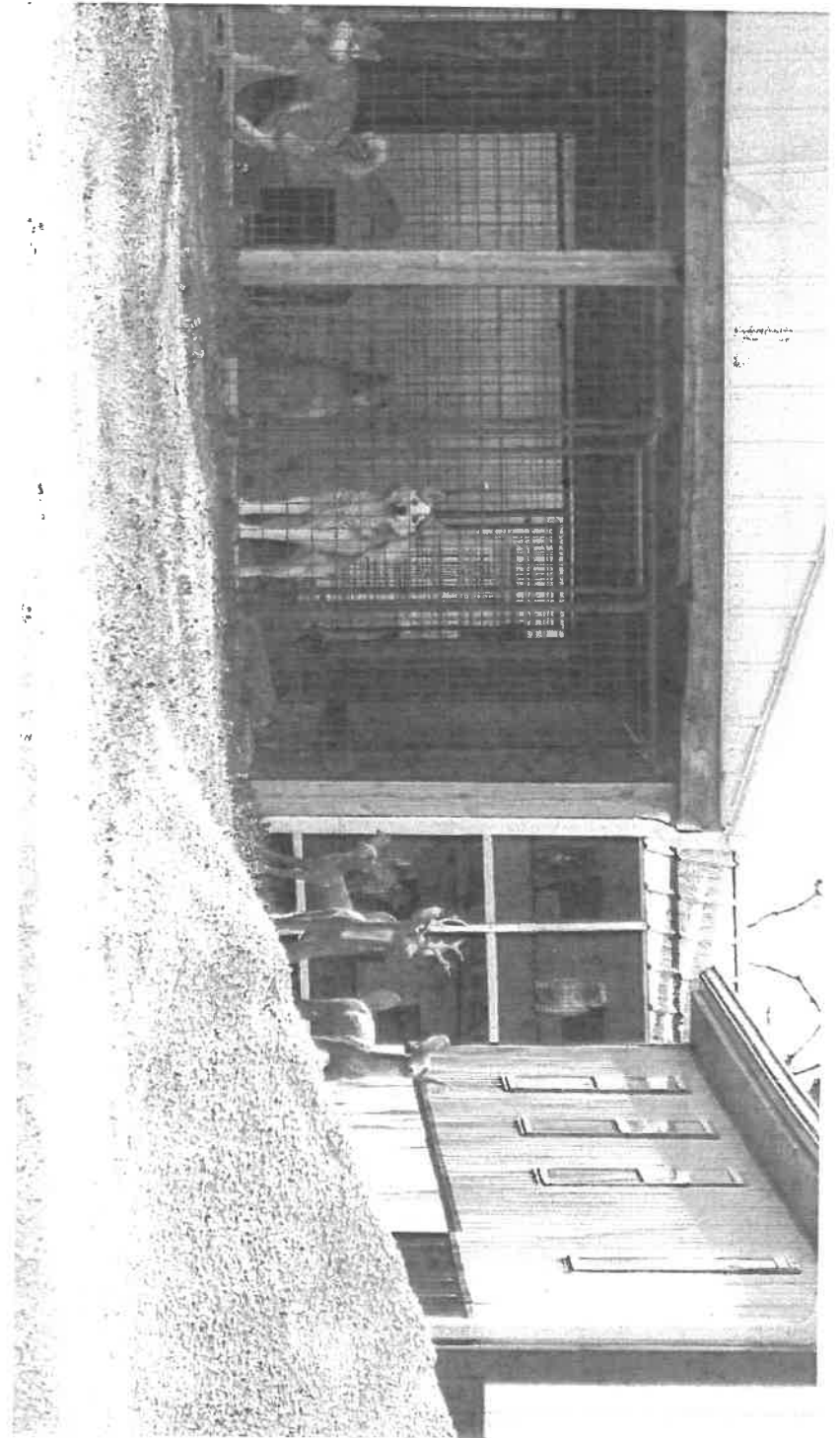
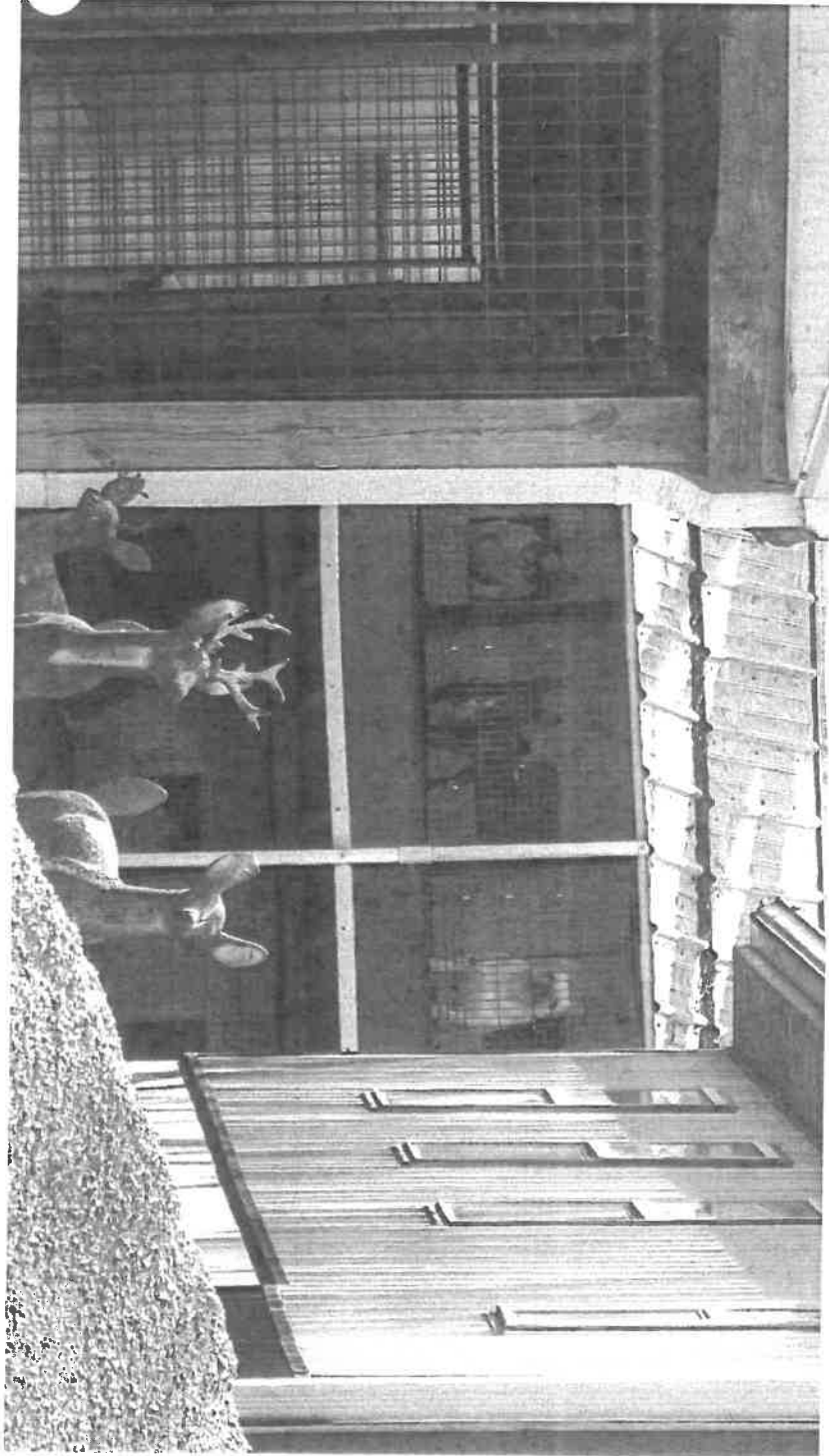

The outside wire runs of the Stacker building that are coated with a material (plastic/fiberglass/rubber, etc.) have numerous missing pieces of the material, leaving bare wire that is not adequate flooring for dogs to walk on. Metal strands of wire used for flooring must be greater than 1/8 of an inch in diameter (9 gauge) or coated. These missing pieces of coating leave the metal wire strands that dogs are walking on bare and less than 9 gauge. This flooring must be repaired or replaced in a manner that can maintain a safe environment for dogs to walk. This will help ensure that the dogs in this building are on flooring that will allow them to move around comfortable and be injury free.

The outside wire runs of the Stacker building that are coated with a material (plastic/fiberglass/rubber, etc.) have numerous missing pieces of the material, leaving bare wire that is not adequate flooring for dogs to walk on. Metal strands of wire used for flooring must be greater than 1/8 of an inch in diameter (9 gauge) or coated. These missing pieces of coating leave the wire flooring less than 9 gauge. The rolled/painted black plastic like coating that was put on the bare wire flooring since the last inspection is not adequately covering the wire and has peeled off. This flooring must be repaired or replaced in a manner that can maintain a safe environment for dogs to walk. This will help ensure that the dogs in this building are on flooring that will allow them to move around comfortable and be injury free.

Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

At time of inspection the outdoor shelters were covered in brown coating of grime. The enclosures (indoor portion) of the sheltered facility, housing puppies, had a build up of brown grime on the walls, floor and heating pad. A build up of hair was noted along the front of the same enclosures. The outdoor portion of the sheltered facility, housing adults, exhibited an accumulation of fecal material. Cleaning of the primary enclosures, removing excreta and sanitizing, is extremely important to reduce disease hazards, prevent soiling of the dogs, insects, pests and odors. The licensee shall implement a proactive cleaning regimen to include sanitizing and additional aggregate (outdoors) to assist the cleaning process.

Veterinary care for dogs.

At time of inspection the hands on exams, conducted on 6/25/21, noted the dental disease score of each animal. The program of Veterinary Care outlined a plan of action for animals exhibiting a dental score of 4 dental disease. The plan of action is to have a complete dental prophylaxis treatment within 6 month of diagnosis. There were 12 dogs noted to have a grade 4 dental disease on the hands on exam document. The 12 dogs diagnosed with the grade 4 dental disease have not had a complete dental prophylaxis at time of inspection.

Dental disease can cause significant health issues if left untreated. Following the outlined procedure required by the Attending Veterinarian is important to the animals health and well-being. The licensee shall make arrangements to have the animals, noted with the grade 4 dental disease, treated as prescribed by the Attending Veterinarian. In addition, the preventative care should include properly trimmed nails. One of the adult female Corgi (941000022312240) was exhibiting long nails that curved to the side due to their excessive length. Improper nail care can cause an impact on the animals health and well-being. The licensee shall implement the nail care preventative as outlined by the Attending Veterinarian.

1st Surfaces - Some whelp/puppy boxes showed extensively that prevents proper cleaning. Some doghouses outside have openings showed openings. Some of the water buckets are bent causing tears in metal w/ sharp edges that could injure dog.

2nd Shelter - 2 doghouses are missing floor for one of members of dog. They are missing. Repair a couple of doghouses. One bathroom had wet straw in doghouses & pen was wet throughout. This did not allow drying area for it.

3rd Maintenance - 1 Bathroom pen had pipe frames consisting of rusting.

4th Sanitation - Elevated runs w/ big dogs have feces building up on the areas where the wooden braces are under the wire. Puppies hair coat looked greasy. Owner stated man causes that from feces in pen. Consider larger pen for those as cleaning more frequently.

5th Electric - Repair 1 bulb in sheltered building.

6th Cleaning - Small dog plastic whelp boxes - some showed underside & unable to clean properly. Outside doghouses appear to be gummy. A large portion of water buckets have mineral build-up. Inside of building nooks fell clean-up. Heavy grime, dust, etc.

Unguarded light bulbs can cause burns when they come into contact with the dogs. The licensee must that housing facilities protect the animals from injury. Correct by 4/27/16.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

* A strong odor was detected coming from the settlement pond during the inspection of this facility. The odor was evident throughout the entire facility. The settlement pond is centrally located in the middle of the dogs being housed in outdoor enclosures. In addition, there was a buildup of fecal waste and flies located along the edge of the settlement pond. The licensee stated that the pond was last pumped in December 2015. Fecal waste buildup over time can allow for strong odors to exist and attract pests which can transmit disease. Fecal waste needs to be removed often enough to help reduce potential disease or health risks to the dogs. The licensee must maintain all outdoor settlement ponds in a manner to prevent odors, diseases, pests and vermin infestation. Correct by 4/27/16.

* **Albuidup of dried, caked feed and debris** was observed in the interior of 15 food receptacles. A lack of cleaning of the receptacles could promote bacteria growth and other disease causing agents which could increase the risk of contamination of the feed. The nutritive value could be affected if the feed becomes spoiled or contaminated that could lead to potential health risks. The licensee must ensure that measures are taken to ensure that there is no molding, deterioration or caking of the feed.
