Your response is important!

The Port Salemo CRA and its consultant are designing improvements in the New Monrovia Neighborhood, which include new sidewalks and raised intersections at SE 47th Avenue and SE Murray Street and at SE Colee Avenue and SE Deli Street.

A raised intersection is a traffic calming feature where the pavement is elevated, much like a speed table, creating a plateau that motorists drive over more slowly. In this design, the pedestrians using the new sidewalks will also cross the raised intersections making the crossing more visible and accessible.


