Please accept this letter as FPL's request to the Martin County Board of County Commissioners for a renewal of the Tangible Personal Property Tax Grant for our Central Distribution Facility and additional vacant parcel of land at the existing Indiantown Co-gen site, both in the Village of Indiantown.

For tax years 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027, and 2028, beginning January 1, 2024, we request a grant payment, as negotiated with the Martin County Board of County Commissioners, of an amount equal to sixty percent (60%) of the tangible personal property tax paid to Martin County each year [fifty percent (50%) on Fire/Rescue MSTU] by FPL for parcel identification numbers 1000-6002-7823 and 1000-60035558.
