Maureen is the mother of a young adult son with a substance use disorder who is in long term recovery. Her son became addicted in Broward County FL during the height of the “Pill Mills” to legally prescribed opioids. Upon becoming aware of her son’s addiction, she began seeking resources and examining the question “why” of the grossly negligent and ongoing “legal” narcotic over prescribing. Her activism has led her to be either an officer or member of many advocacy and support groups since 2009 including an appointment to the Broward County Substance Abuse Advisory Board by the now FL Representative Kristen Jacobs, formerly Broward County Commissioner. Past member of FL State Attorney Dave Aronberg’s Sober Home Task Force, invited speaker at the Palm Beach County Opioid Roundtable hosted by former Mayor McKinlay and FL Senators and Representatives, and testified for the FL Sober Home Grand Jury Report. In addition, Maureen provided testimony to the FDA regarding proposed narcotic Moxduo in 2014 and participated with the Washington, DC, Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) 2013 Work Plan. She is a past member of both the Advocacy and Steering Committees of the nationally known FedUp Coalition which has led her to meeting with multiple federal and congressional representatives and national advocates.

Currently Maureen is the President of Southeast Florida Recovery Advocates (SEFRA) that covers Martin, St. Lucie, Palm Beach, Broward and Miami-Dade Counties whose mission is to assemble a forum through which education, prevention, treatment and recovery advocacy groups align, working towards common objectives surrounding all aspects of recover from substance use and related disorders. Maureen is past Chairperson of the Palm Beach County Opioid Response Plan Steering Committee.

Maureen holds a Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management from Temple University, Philadelphia, PA. Her professional background, over 30 years’ of administrative healthcare experience, has prepared her extremely well to delve into and analyze the multiple statutory, regulatory, social and legal issues surrounding this national CDC declared prescription drug epidemic and public health emergency.
