A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO  
NEIGHBORHOOD ADVISORY COMMITTEES

**WHEREAS**, the Martin County Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Martin County Code Section 7 1/3-5, as amended by Section 39.4.A. provided for the creation of Neighborhood Advisory Committees; and the required qualifications of Neighborhood Advisory Committee members; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 39.4.A.1.b., Martin County Code, sets forth the number of members of Neighborhood Advisory Committees as five to nine members; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution 18-9.29, the Board of County Commissioners established the number of members of each Neighborhood Advisory Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the number of members of each Neighborhood Advisory Committee should be updated to reflect community involvement.




