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**THIRD AMENDMENT TO COASTAL WASTE & RECYCLING  
PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT ZONING AGREEMENT  
(F/K/A NU-WAY RECYCLING)**

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO COASTAL WASTE & RECYCLING PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT ZONING AGREEMENT ("Third Amendment") made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2026, by and between COASTAL WASTE & RECYCLING OF MARTIN COUNTY, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, hereinafter referred to as OWNER, and MARTIN COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY.

**WITNESSETH:**

WHEREAS, after appropriate notice, public hearing and approval, Nu-Way Recycling Corp., a Florida corporation ("Nu-Way"), and COUNTY on the 21st day of December 2004, entered into a Planned Unit Development Zoning Agreement for the development of a project known as NU-WAY RECYCLING CORP., which Planned Unit Development Zoning Agreement, is recorded in Official Records Book 1996, beginning at Page 1637 of the Public Records of Martin County, Florida ("Original Agreement"); which has been amended from through and including that certain Second Amendment to Coastal Waste & Recycling Planned Unit Development and Zoning Agreement, dated March 22, 2023, and recorded in Official Records Book 3372, beginning at Page 250, of the Public Records of Martin County, Florida, ("Second Amendment"). The

Original Agreement and all amendments thereto, being collectively referred to as the “PUD Agreement”; and

WHEREAS, OWNER, acquired all right, title and interest to the property subject to the PUD Agreement, as reflected in the Special Warranty Deed between Nu-Way and OWNER, dated November 30, 2017, recorded December 6, 2017, in Official Records Book 2963, Page 319 of the Public Records of Martin County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, OWNER further desires to amend the PUD Agreement to revise, Revised Exhibit D, - Revised Master/Final Site Plan, Revised Exhibit E - Timetable for Development and Revised Exhibit F, Coastal Waste & Recycling – Special Conditions, of the PUD Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. Revised Exhibit D, - Revised Master/Final Site Plan is amended and replaced in its entirety with the attached and incorporated Revised Exhibit D, - Revised Master/Final Site Plan.

Exhibit D is revised to reflect the following:

- 2.1 The addition of an approximately 7,800 square foot maintenance shop to support the current service vehicles.
- 2.2 The addition of an approximately 4,000 square foot office that will include a breakroom, restrooms and training center for operations and employees.
- 2.3 The repaved asphalt loop road with the addition of thirty-nine (39) 10' x 20' parking spaces for the proposed Office and Vehicular Service buildings and forty-two (42) 12' x 35' truck storage spaces that support overall operations.
3. Revised Exhibit E, - Timetable for Development, is hereby replaced in its entirety with the

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attached and incorporated Revised Exhibit E, - Timetable for Development.

4. Revised Exhibit F, - Coastal Waste & Recycling – Special Conditions is modified by the addition of subsection E under Special Condition 17, which reads as follows:

4.1     E. Within 60-days of approval of this Third Amendment, OWNER shall pay to the Martin County Public Works Department the sum of \$25,000.00, which shall be used for the maintenance of SE Suzanne Drive.

5. All of the terms and conditions of the PUD Agreement which are not specifically amended or revised by this Third Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this PUD Agreement to be made and entered into the day and year first written. The date of this PUD Agreement shall be the date on which this PUD Agreement was approved by the Board of County Commissioners.
