NON-EXCLUSIVE FLOW-THROUGH DRAINAGE AND ACCESS EASEMENT

THIS NON-EXCLUSIVE FLOW-THROUGH DRAINAGE AND ACCESS EASEMENT granted and executed this __/_ day of __Seplember__, 2025, by STUART AUTO VAULT LLC, a Florida limited liability company, whose address is 2100 SE Ocean Blvd, Suite 100, Stuart, Florida 34996, Grantor, to MARTIN COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is 2401 S.E. Monterey Road, Stuart, Florida 34996, Grantee.

(Wherever used herein the terms "Grantor" and "Grantee" shall include singular and plural, heirs, legal representatives, and assigns of individuals, and the successors and assigns of corporations, wherever the context so admits or requires.)

WITNESSETH that the Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 in hand paid by the Grantee, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto the Grantee forever, a perpetual non-exclusive flow-through drainage and access easement on, over, under, across and through the land described and depicted on **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Easement Premises") to ensure the free flow of water for general public drainage purposes, over, through and under the Easement Premises, and use of a surface and sub-surface drainage system, and for ingress and egress across, over, and upon the Easement Premises as may be reasonably necessary, to carry out the purposes of this easement.
