A Proclamation

Declaring Alcohol Awareness Month in Martin County, Florida

Whereas, the Martin County Community Action Coalition is coordinating activities in recognition of April 2023 as Alcohol Awareness Month in Martin County; and

Whereas, such a declaration provides advocates for the prevention of underage drinking and substance abuse an opportunity to educate the public and elected officials about the societal and financial effectiveness of prevention education; and

Whereas, alcohol abuse is a major public health concern that affects millions of Americans of all ages, races and ethnic backgrounds in all communities which also has a huge medical, societal and economic cost; and

Whereas, community efforts, including activities, events and education regarding the effects of alcohol and substance abuse, are dedicated to the prevention of underage drinking and other related risk behaviors among Martin County youth.

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that April 2023 is Alcohol Awareness Month in Martin County, Florida.
