SUBJECT: CONTRACTS THAT MEET THE THRESHOLD FOR BOARD APPROVAL \$1 MILLION OR GREATER

- A. CONTRACTS OVER \$1,000,000 Per Board direction, contracts valued at \$1,000,000 or more require approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
  - 1. INDIAN RIVERSIDE PARK LIVING SHORELINE (RFB2024-3622) Construction of twenty-four breakwaters and installation of approximately 2,000 feet of mangrove toe protection stones along the shore of Indian Riverside Park. The Project will also include beach escarpment restoration, demolition and removal of an existing seawall, and removal of submerged debris within the breakwater footprint.

Project was publicly bid (bid tabulation attached).

**Fiscal Impact:** This project is funded in part by a State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Grant Agreement (22SRP07) and a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Grant (#DR-4337/PW #37285-5356).

## **Recommended Action:**

- 1. Move that the Board award the contract to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder, Custom Built Marine Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$2,748,044.21; and
- 2. Move that the Board authorize the County Administrator or designee to execute all documents related to this request.

Per Board direction, all bidders have been notified of the recommendation of award and Board meeting date.
