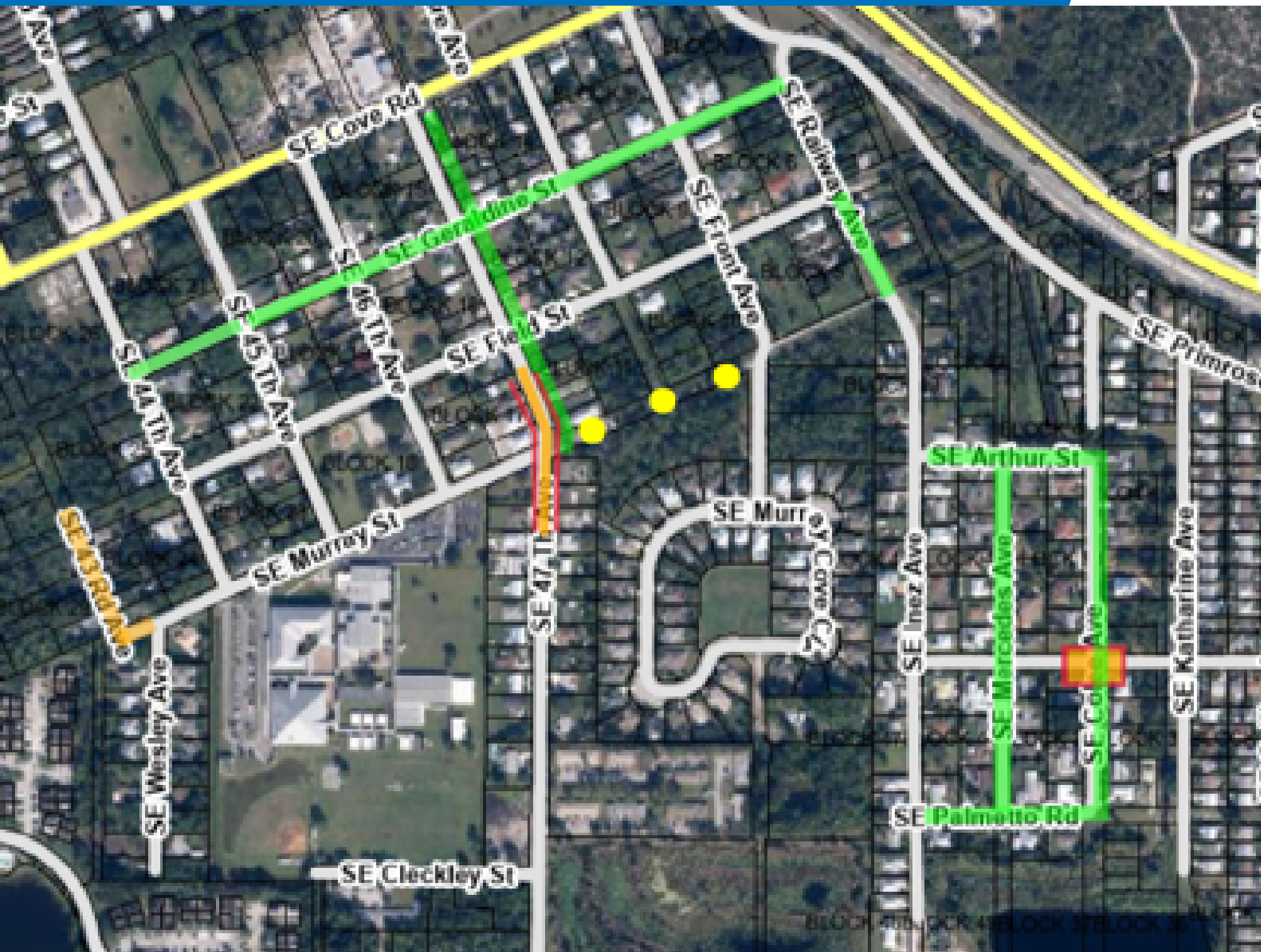

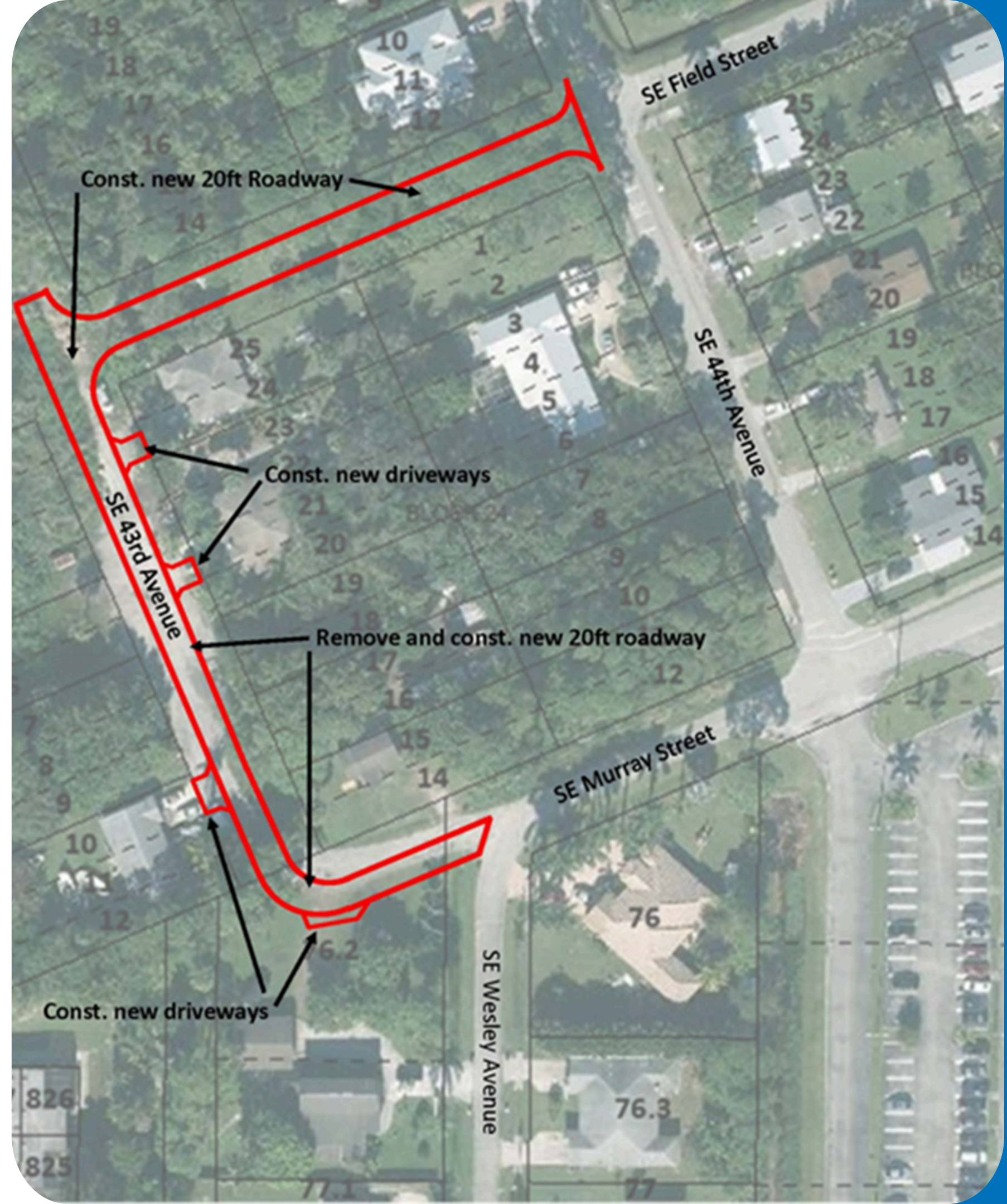
New Monrovia Neighborhood Improvements

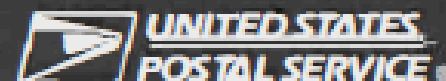
Potential Post Office™ Relocation Comment Period
