NEW BUSINESS

Agenda Item: 25-0613: Golden Gate – Landscape Vision Plan

Joy Puerta, CRA Program Manager provided a presentation on the potential landscape improvements in Golden Gate including 1) the SE Dixie Highway medians between SE Indian Street and SE Jefferson Street, 2) SE Bonita Street, SE Clayton Street, and SE Delmar Street between SE Dixie Highway and SE Birch Avenue and 3) SE Birch Avenue between SE Bonita Street and SE Clayton Street.

S. Tsaftarides – Who maintains the current landscape now? We need sidewalks in Golden Gate.

J. Puerta – The Field Operation Division maintains the landscaping and has been removing trees and landscaping that are failing. This project will enhance the landscaped areas to improve the pedestrian visibility at crosswalks. In addition, it will promote planting the right tree in the right place to avoid overhead wires. The project includes a landscaped walkway along SE Birch Avenue between SE Clayton Street and SE Delmar Street. Sidewalks are being addressed in the Neighborhood Improvements Project, presented at the October 2024 NAC meeting.

M. Capps – I would like to see a proposal on how much the design will cost.

Agenda Item: 25-0611; Golden Gate – FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan

Joy Puerta, CRA Program Manager provided a presentation for the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). Discussions included, how the CIP identifies and prioritizes capital projects, how the Tax Increment Financing (TIP) works, what's in the Golden Gate CRA Redevelopment Plan and the current and proposed projects. Projects recommended for funding included the CRA Investment Program, El Camino, Landscape Vision Plan, Neighborhood Improvement Plan and an updated lighting study for a total of \$829,000.00.

S. Tsaftarides – We need more lighting in Golden Gate.

S. Hetherington – There was a lighting study done before my term, about 9 years ago for the Golden Gate area that could be reviewed.

J. Puerta – I will research the existing files and request the Sheriff's Office update the study.
