RESOLUTION NO. 26-

**AUTHORIZING PERMISSION TO APPLY FOR A SMALL COUNTY OUTREACH PROGRAM
(SCOP) GRANT BETWEEN MARTIN COUNTY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE SW 84TH AVENUE AND SW
BUSCH STREET RESURFACING AND RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of County Commissioners has made the following determinations of fact:

1. Martin County Board of County Commissioners will request funding assistance by the FDOT for the SW 84th Avenue and SW Busch Street Resurfacing and Reconstruction project, which provides for joint responsibilities of FDOT and the County and to deliver such Application to FDOT.
2. Martin County Board of County Commissioners has legal ownership of all designated Right of Way within the project limits of the SW 84th Avenue and SW Busch Street Resurfacing and Reconstruction Project.
3. The Board has determined that it is appropriate to enter into an appropriate Agreement with FDOT and will commit to local match funding of the project in the amount of \$445,846.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Martin County, Florida:

- A. The Board hereby authorizes the Director of the Martin County Public Works Department, or designee, to sign and deliver to FDOT the Small County Outreach Program Application request for funding assistance for the SW 84th Avenue and SW Busch Street Resurfacing and Reconstruction Project.
