IV. Agenda Items

A. County Capital Improvement Projects

Martin County Senior Project Engineer Keith Baker presented updates on neighborhood restoration projects, roadway/sidewalk construction, and bridge projects.

School Board Member Christia Li Roberts requested an approximate time frame for the Jensen Beach resurfacing project. Keith Baker advised the project is expected to be completed by the summer.

Environmental Resource Administrator John Maehl presented the Environmental updates to the Boards.

City of Stuart Commissioner Eula Clarke commended the County on their environmental efforts.

For the public's benefit, School Board Member Amy Pritchett requested clarification on the 'wasteful funding' of Bathtub Beach. Environmental Resource Administrator John Maehl and Commissioner Doug Smith clarified and provided insights into the re-nourishment project.

Traffic Engineering Manager Luke Lambert presented traffic project updates.

B. City Utilities and Engineering Projects
