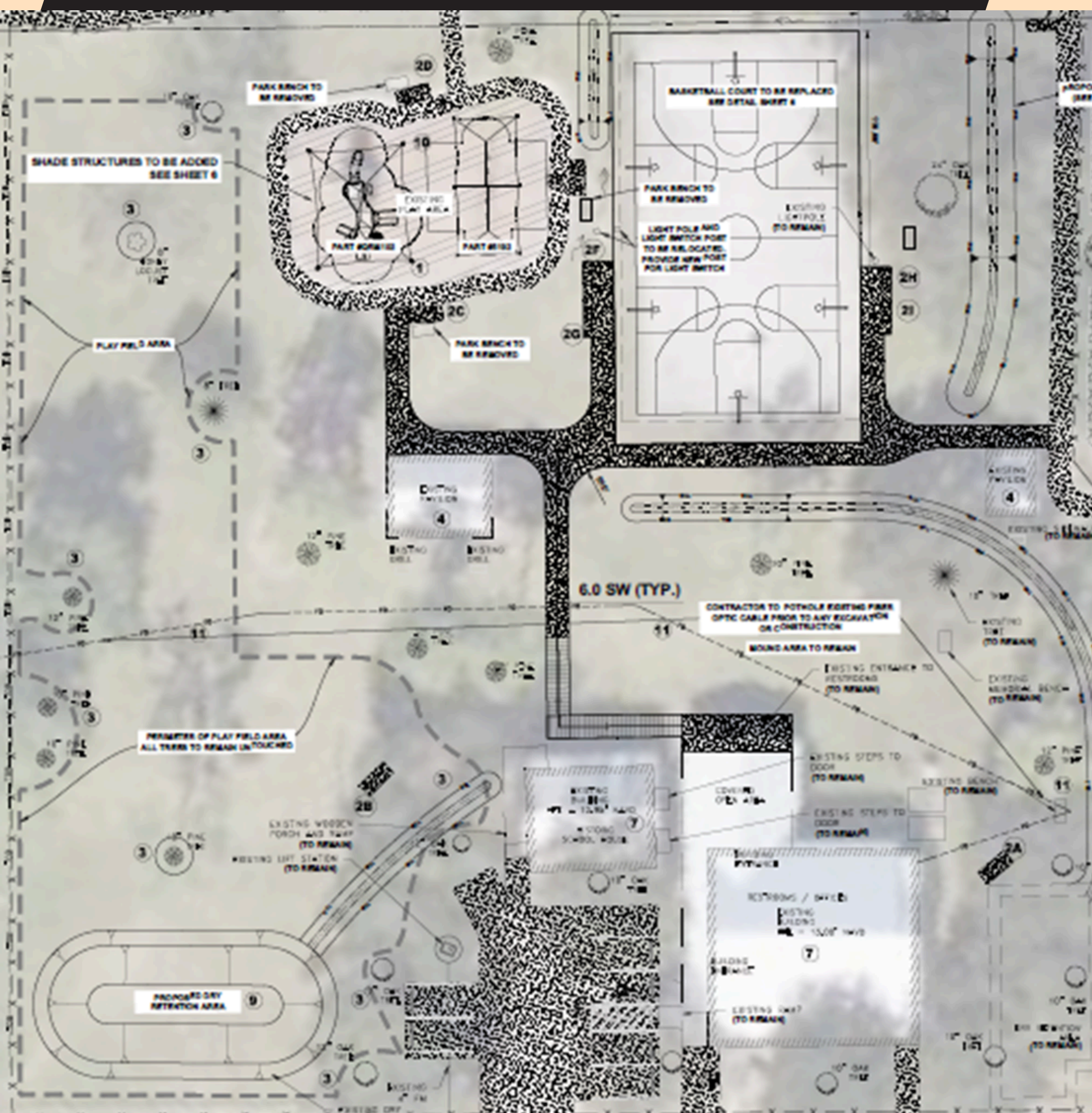

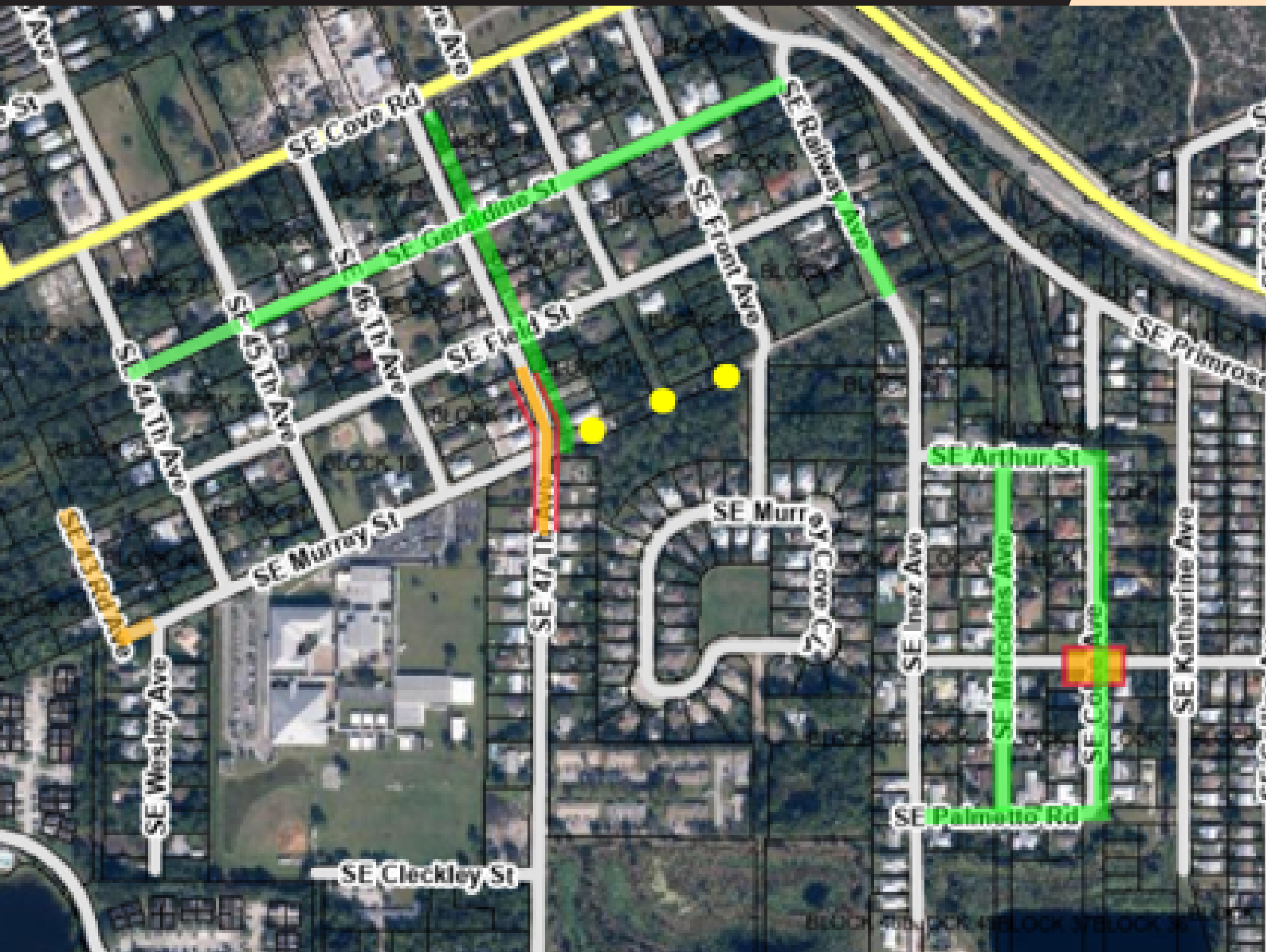

Raised Intersections



You are receiving this numbered ballot to decide whether to raise two intersections in the New Monrovia Neighborhood.

Your response is important!

The Port Salerno CRA and its consultant are designing improvements in the New Monrovia Neighborhood, which include new sidewalks and raised intersections at SE 47th Avenue and SE Murray Street and at SE Colee Avenue and SE Dell Street.

A raised intersection is a traffic calming feature where the pavement is elevated, much like a speed table, creating a plateau that motorists drive over more slowly. In this design, the pedestrians using the new sidewalks will also cross the raised intersections making the crossing more visible and accessible.



In Martin County, an overwhelming majority of the affected residents' support is required before traffic calming features can be considered. A numbered ballot is being sent to each potentially affected property owner, whose names and addresses were obtained from the Martin County Property Appraisers Office's database.
