**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE INSTALLATION OF A
TRAFFIC SIGNAL ON SE WILLOUGHBY BOULEVARD**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 316.008(1)(b), Fla. Stat., this Board is authorized to regulate the streets, highways and bridges under its jurisdiction, including regulating traffic by means of official traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, SE Willoughby Boulevard is a public arterial that is owned and maintained by Martin County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stuart has approved a Major Development Site Plan consisting of 135 single-story flex warehouse units known as Baron Business Park, which is located at 2601 SE Willoughby Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, an entrance to the Baron Business Park is on SE Willoughby Boulevard is aligned with the entrance to the Martin County High School; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of the approval, the applicant is required to construct left and right turn lanes and a traffic signal at the entrance on SE Willoughby Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of the Right-of-way Use Permit for the traffic signal and turn lanes, the County Engineer is requiring the removal of the existing school zone on SE Willoughby Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, this Board has deemed the installation of a traffic signal on SE Willoughby Boulevard at the entrance to the Martin County High School will be appropriate and in the best interest of the citizens of Martin County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County, Florida:

- A. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the installation of a traffic signal on SE Willoughby Boulevard at the entrance to the Martin County High School; and
- B. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the removal of the traffic signal control devices, signs, and markings that establish a school zone on SE Willoughby Boulevard at its entrance to the Martin County High School; and
- C. The County Engineer is hereby directed to notify the Martin County Sheriff's Office, the Martin County High School Principal's Office, and the City of Stuart Police Department of this Resolution.
