**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE INSTALLATION OF A
TRAFFIC SIGNAL ON SR-5 (US-1 / SE FEDERAL HIGHWAY) AT ITS
INTERSECTION WITH SE CONSTITUTION BOULEVARD**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Sec. 31 6.008(b), Fla. Stat., this Board is authorized to regulate the streets, highways and bridges within its jurisdiction, including regulating traffic by means of official traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, SE Constitution Boulevard is a County-owned and County-maintained minor collector roadway; and

WHEREAS, this Board has deemed the installation of a traffic signal on SE Constitution Boulevard is appropriate and is in the best interest of the Citizens of Martin County, Florida.

WHEREAS, SR-5 (US-1 / SE Federal Highway) is a State-owned and State-maintained major arterial roadway; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation has permitted the installation of a traffic signal on SR-5 (US-1 / SE Federal Highway).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County, Florida:

- A. The Public Works Department is hereby authorized to procure and construct a traffic signal on SR-5 (US-1 / SE Federal Highway) at its intersection with SE Constitution Boulevard.
- B. The Public Works Department staff is hereby directed to notify the Martin County Sheriffs Office of this Resolution.
- C. All previous resolutions related to the traffic control on SE Constitution Boulevard in the vicinity of SR-5 (US-1 / SE Federal Highway) are hereby deemed null and void prospectively.
