**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF STUART, FLORIDA
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE
AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF STUART AND MARTIN
COUNTY TO PROVIDE MAINTENANCE OF
TRAFFIC SIGNAL CABINETS WITH
DECORATIVE ART WRAP; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2023, the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Board approved to wrap the traffic signal cabinets within the Community Redevelopment Area boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Community Redevelopment Board and CRA Board approved appropriation for the Traffic Signal Cabinets Artwork Wrap Project in the FY 2024 CRA's budget; and

WHEREAS, the traffic signal cabinets are operated by Martin County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stuart and Martin County entered into an Interlocal Agreement on August 5, 2014, for Traffic Signal Maintenance; and

Resolution No. 98-2024; Interlocal Agreement with Martin County – Traffic signal maintenance.

WHEREAS, Community Redevelopment Agency coordinated with Martin County to identify the traffic signal cabinets to apply vinyl wrap to the exterior surface of the cabinets within the Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2024, the City Commission considered Resolution No. 86-2024, amending the interlocal agreement with Martin County for traffic signal maintenance associated with installation and maintenance of the wrap; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission recommended approval of Resolution No. 86-2024 with the condition that the County shall be responsible for the costs of the damages to the wrap caused by County while performing operations or maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the County did not agree with the additional condition, so the matter is returning to the City Commission for a final determination.

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2024, the City Commission re-considered this matter by Resolution No. 98-2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF STUART, FLORIDA that:

SECTION 1: The City Commission of the City of Stuart hereby authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Stuart and Martin County to provide for maintenance of traffic signal cabinets with decorative art wrap, as attached hereto as “Exhibit 1”.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.







**FIRST AMENDMENT
TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE
BETWEEN MARTIN COUNTY AND THE CITY OF STUART
DATED AUGUST 5, 2014**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the Interlocal Agreement for Traffic Signal Maintenance is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2024 by and between Martin County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, 2401 SE Monterey Road, Stuart, Florida 34996 (“COUNTY”) and the City of Stuart, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, 121 SW Flagler Avenue, Stuart, Florida 34994 (the “CITY”).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, COUNTY and the CITY entered into an Interlocal Agreement on August 5, 2014 for Traffic Signal Maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the CITY wishes to enhance traffic signal system cabinets with decorative art wrap (WRAP) on COUNTY maintained systems within municipal limits; and

WHEREAS, the parties would like to amend the Interlocal Agreement to clarify certain responsibilities for traffic signal maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the parties hereby are to amend their Interlocal Agreement as follows:

1. The CITY will present the WRAP to the COUNTY for its review and approval.
2. The CITY will provide the COUNTY with five (5) calendar days-notice prior to the installation of the WRAP.
3. The CITY is solely responsible for all costs associated with installation, maintenance, replacement and removal of the WRAP.
4. The COUNTY shall not incur any costs related to the WRAP, including but not limited to, any damage cause by the COUNTY’s operations or maintenance in or around the traffic signal system cabinets.
5. Unless specifically modified by this First Amendment, all remaining terms shall remain in full force and effect.
6. This First Amendment of the Interlocal Agreement shall become effective upon execution by both parties and filing with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Martin County.




