Recognizing Public Works Week in Martin County, Florida

Whereas, public works professionals are dedicated to maintaining infrastructure, facilities and essential services that support sustainable, resilient communities while enhancing public health, quality of life and overall well-being in Martin County; and

Whereas, these facilities, services and infrastructure could not be provided without the expertise and efforts of public works professionals, who are engineers, managers and employees at all levels of government and the private sector. These professionals are responsible for rebuilding, improving and protecting our nation's transportation, water supply, water treatment and solid waste systems, public buildings and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens; and

Whereas, it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders and children in Martin County to gain knowledge of and maintain an ongoing interest and understanding of the importance of public works projects and programs in their respective communities; and

Whereas, the year 2026 marks the 66th annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association.

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that May 17-23, 2026 shall be known as Public Works Week in Martin County.
