outside diameter injection casing set to approximately 2,800 feet below land surface (bls), an 18-inch nominal size tubing set to approximately 2,790 feet bls with a cemented annulus (alternate design), and total drilled depth of approximately 3,350 feet bls.

The injection wells are designed for a maximum injection rate of 6,705 gallons per minute and a maximum injection volume of 9.65 million gallons per day per well at an injection velocity of 10 feet per second in the proposed injection tubing of each well. The dual-zone monitor well (MW-1) is proposed to be completed in the Floridan aquifer with an upper monitor zone at 1,500 bls to 1,550 feet bls and a lower monitor zone at 1,800 to 1,850 feet bls. The Department has permitting jurisdiction under Chapter 403 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) and the rules adopted thereunder. The project is not exempt from permitting procedures. The Department has determined that an Underground Injection Control permit is required for the proposed work.
