



**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY AND CONTRACTOR
RFP2020-3233**

THIS AMENDMENT #3 made and entered into this 1st day of December in the year 2023, by and between **MARTIN COUNTY**, a political subdivision of Florida, (Hereinafter "County") and **MTM TRANSIT** (Hereinafter "Contractor").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the **County** and **Contractor** entered into an Agreement for On-Road Transit and Support Services on October 1, 2020, as amended by Amendment #2 on November 15th, 2022 (hereinafter collectively "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS the **County** and **Contractor** desire to amend the Agreement to reflect the following changes to Exhibit A, the total contract not to exceed amount, Exhibit B - Fixed Route Unit Hourly Rates, Exhibit C - Paratransit Unit Trip Rates.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises, covenants, and mutual benefits which all accrue to the parties hereto in carrying out the terms of this Agreement, it is mutually covenanted and agreed that the scope of the Agreement shall be changed as described herein.

1. Exhibit A - Third Rate Schedule is removed in its entirety and replaced with the attached Exhibit A – Fourth Rate Schedule.
2. Exhibit B - Fixed Route Unit Hourly Rates is removed in its entirety and replaced with the attached Exhibit B - Fixed Route Unit Hourly Rates.
3. Exhibit C - Paratransit Unit Trip Rates is removed in its entirety and replaced with the attached Exhibit C - Paratransit Unit Trip Rates.
4. All remaining pricing, terms and conditions of the Agreement not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.
