Drug & Alcohol Abuse Awareness Committee Vacancies

The Martin County Board of County Commissioners is seeking applications from individuals interested in being considered for appointment to fill vacancies on the **Drug & Alcohol Abuse Awareness Committee**. All individuals serve without compensation and are requested to apply for appointment to Martin County Administration **by Friday, December 12**, 2025. Powers & Duties:

The Drug and Alcohol Abuse Awareness Committee shall serve as an advisory committee to the Board of County Commissioners on issues relating to adult and youth substance and alcohol abuse in Martin County. The Committee will make recommendations on programs and services that impact the community. Meetings are held quarterly, or more frequently as directed by staff or the Committee Chair to discuss activities pertaining to substance/alcohol abuse among youth and adults in Martin County. Failure to attend three consecutive meetings is grounds for automatic removal from the committee.

Vacant positions: a treatment representative and two private citizens. These are three-year terms.

Florida law prohibits an advisory board member from doing business with its agency (the County). Section 112.313(3) and (7), Fla. Stat.

Meetings are held *quarterly* at 3:00 pm at the Administrative Building, 2401 SE Monterey Road, Stuart. The next meetings are March 11, June 10, September 9, and December 9, 2026.
