The Public Art Advisory Committee (PAAC) appointed a Subcommittee to review applications submitted in response to the Call for Artists for a mosaic installation on the Manatee Pocket Mooring Field Upland Facility. A publicly noticed meeting was convened to review the 15 submissions. Using prescribed scoring criteria, Subcommittee members reviewed, scored, and discussed all applications. Three finalists were brought to the PAAC on July 28th. They reviewed the applications using the same criteria and made a recommendation of two artworks for final selection and approval.
