### Program Overview


- Established in 1997

### • Funding

- Set-aside of 1% on eligible County projects
- Annual allocation by BOCC: \$50,000 if no revenue

### • Fund Distribution

- 70% allocated to art
- 30% allocated to administration/maintenance








1. How important do you believe public art is for enhancing our community?




2. How would you rate the overall impact of Martin County's Art in Public Places program?






# 3. What types of public art would you like to see more of in Martin County?






# 4. Where do you think public art installations would have the most impact?
