**RESOLUTION GRANTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AUTHORITY TO
DISPOSE OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY MARTIN COUNTY
PURSUANT TO SECTION 274.07, FLORIDA STATUTES.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) is required by Chapter 274, Florida Statutes to maintain records on tangible personal property of a non-consumable nature; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of this resolution, the word “property” means fixtures and other tangible personal property of a nonconsumable nature.

WHEREAS, upon the expiration of the useful life of property, in accordance with established policies and procedures, the County disposes of such property; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined it is in the best interests of the County to formally memorialize the County Administrator’s authority for the disposal of property pursuant to Section 274.07, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MARTIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, THAT:

The County Administrator is granted the authority to dispose of property owned by Martin County pursuant to Section 274.07, Florida Statutes.
