**Recognizing Public Works Week in Martin County, Florida**

**Whereas**, public works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life and well-being of the people of Martin County; and

**Whereas**, these infrastructure, facilities and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, who are engineers, managers and employees at all levels of government and the private sector. These professionals are responsible for rebuilding, improving and protecting our nation's transportation, water supply, water treatment and solid waste systems, public buildings, and other structures and facilities essential for our citizens; and

**Whereas**, it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders and children in Martin County to gain knowledge of and maintain an ongoing interest and understanding of the importance of public works and public works programs in their respective communities; and

**Whereas**, the year 2024 marks the 64th annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association.
