Notice is hereby given that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District 4 and the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County, will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, May 20th, 2025** beginning at **1:30 pm** eastern standard time, or as soon thereafter as may be heard, to review a proposed Road Jurisdiction Transfer Agreement regarding changes to:

CR-714 (SW Martin Hwy) from SR-714 (SW Martin Downs Blvd) to SR-76 (S Kanner Hwy);

SE Indian St from SR-76 (S Kanner Hwy) to US-1/SR-5 (SE Federal Hwy);

SR-732 (NW/NE Jensen Beach Blvd) from US-1/SR-5 (NW Federal Hwy) to CR-723 (NE Savannah Rd); and

SR-732 (NE Causeway Blvd) from CR-707 (NE Indian River Dr) to SR-A1A (NE Ocean Blvd)

The Roadway Transfer Agreement between FDOT and Martin County is for the transfer of ownership of: SW Martin Hwy and SE Indian St on to the State Highway System; and NW/NE Jensen Beach Blvd and NE Causeway Blvd off of the State Highway System.
