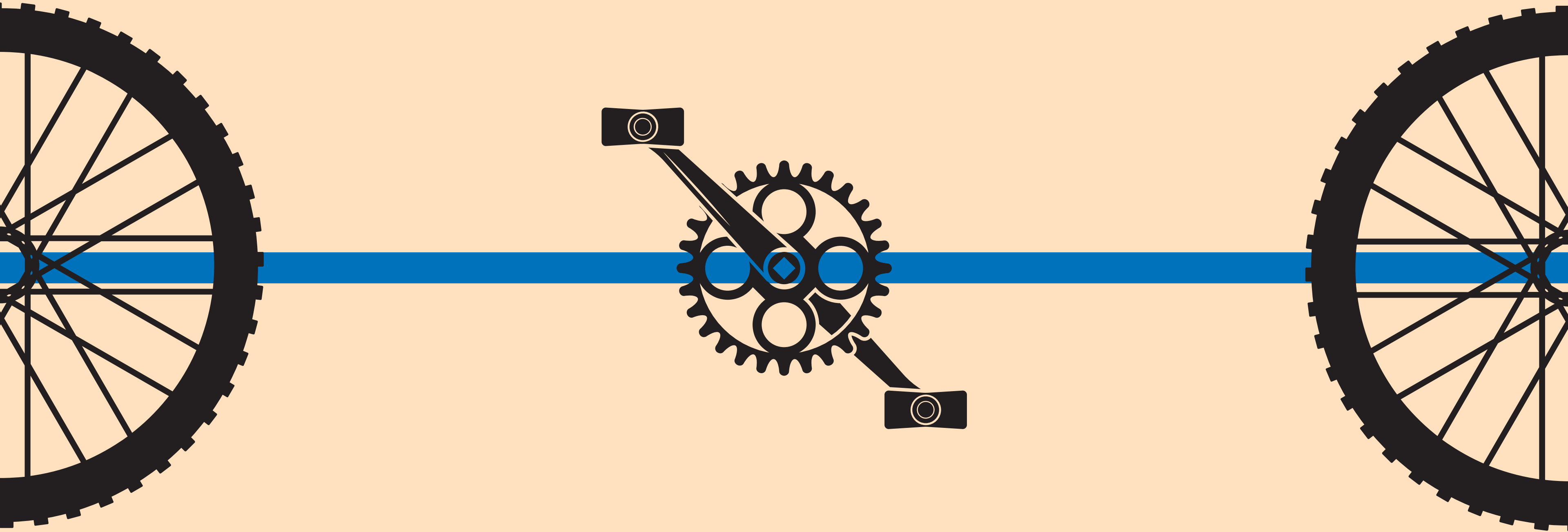




E-Bike Safety



What you need to know about E-bikes!

- Pedal-assisted electric bicycles
- Current bicycle laws apply
- MUST obey traffic laws
- Helmets are required for riders under 16





E-Bikes: Classifications and Rules

E-bikes are classified into three categories: Class 1, Class 2, and Class 3.

	Motor engagement	Max speed	Other details
CLASS 1	Pedal-assist only	20 mph	Electric motor engages only when pedaling
CLASS 2	Throttle and pedal-assist	20 mph	Electric motor can engage with or without pedaling
CLASS 3	Pedal-assist only	28 mph	Electric motor engages only when pedaling

Key Florida E-Bike Regulations



- ← License and Registration: Not required
- ← Where you can ride: Roadways, bike lanes, trails, multi-use paths, and sidewalks, unless prohibited by local ordinance
- ← Age Limit: There is no age limit, but riders under 16 must wear a helmet



What you need to know about E-motos!

- E-Motos are electric motorcycles
- They are NOT street legal
- They are significantly more powerful than an Ebike
- Some models can reach upwards of 70 mph
