A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
 MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CONTRIBUTION
 OF COUNTY FUNDS TO SUPPLEMENT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT
 OF TRANSPORTATION BUDGET FOR THE S KANNER HIGHWAY
 LANDSCAPE ENHANCEMENT PROJECT FROM SE COVE ROAD TO
 SW CABANA POINT CIRCLE

WHEREAS, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has an active project in design to install enhanced landscaping and irrigation on S Kanner Highway between SE Cove Road and SW Cabana Point Circle; and

WHEREAS, at the October 19, 2021 Board of County Commissioner meeting, FDOT asked for a County contribution for the project and the Board directed staff to provide \$250,000 for the project funded out of the Public Works Annual Commitment CIP sheet; and

WHEREAS, FDOT has also asked for the County to enter into a future Landscape Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) to maintain the landscaping in perpetuity once the 2-year establishment period is complete; and

WHEREAS, FDOT requires a formal Resolution to document the County's willingness to contribute to the project and to maintain the enhanced landscaping in the future.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

The Board of County Commissioners of Martin County, Florida, hereby provides commitment to the Florida Department of Transportation that the County will provide \$250,000 in funding to the Department to supplement its budget for the impending project, and to enter into a future Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for maintaining the enhanced landscape.
