Whitney Houston's mother expresses shock at abuse claims

Whitney Houston's mother says allegations that her superstar daughter and her son were molested by her niece are "unfathomable."

In a statement to People magazine on behalf of herself and her sister, singer Dionne Warwick, Clary Houston said they first learned of the claims two days before the documentary "Whitney" premiered in May.

In the film, Whitney Houston's longtime assistant said the singer told her that cousin Dee Dee Warwick molested her as a child and Whitney's oldest brother claimed he, too, was molested.

Dee Dee Warwick died in 2008. Whitney Houston died in 2012.



Release of 5th 'Indiana Jones' movie pushed back to 2021

Indiana Jones won't be swinging back into movie theaters until at least 2021.

The Walt Disney Co. on Tuesday announced that the planned 5th installment in the "Indiana Jones" franchise will be released in July 2021 instead of July 2020. The film was originally set for release in the summer of 2019.

Script issues are reportedly behind the delay. Last month, "Solo: A Star Wars Story" co-screenwriter Jonathan Kasdan was brought on to help write the film.

Steven Spielberg is set to direct the film, with Harrison Ford also reprising his role. Ford turns 79 in July 2021.
