Irene spent time with me answering questions regarding the proposed Glitch Amendment changes for Rio. I had been unable to attend the Rio NAC meeting due to injury from a fall. Most of my concerns cannot be handled through the Glitch Amendment, and I will raise them with the Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council and the Rio NAC during the next stage of review.

By copy of this message I thank Irene for her consideration and patience with me today.

There is one item that I ask you to consider fixing through the Glitch Bill: existing exposed dumpsters. A time limited change that would require that existing exposed dumpsters be enclosed within 3 years. Property owners with existing exposed dumpsters would receive notification of this small improvement that could be made at a modest cost.
