**A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO
NEIGHBORHOOD ADVISORY COMMITTEES**

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Martin County Code Section 7 1/3-5, as amended by Section 39.4.A. provided for the creation of Neighborhood Advisory Committees; and the required qualifications of Neighborhood Advisory Committee members; and

WHEREAS, Section 39.4.A.1.b., Martin County Code, sets forth the number of members of Neighborhood Advisory Committees as five to nine members; and


WHEREAS, by Resolution 18-9.29, the Board of County Commissioners established the number of members of each Neighborhood Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the number of members of each Neighborhood Advisory Committee should be updated to reflect community involvement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of County Commissioners hereby amends the number of members on the Port Salerno Neighborhood Advisory Committee from 7 members to 9 members.


