RESOLUTION NO. 19-10.11

**RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 19-3.4
AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 02-7.33
RELATING TO BUILDING PERMIT FEES**

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2002, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 02-7.33 establishing certain fees relating to building permits; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2019, the Board considered a request from the Building Department to change the building permit fee structure to incentivize appropriate project oversight by contractors and to improve the efficiency of the building permit review and inspection process; and

WHEREAS, the resolution attached to the March 19, 2019 agenda item was not the correct document and accordingly it is necessary to rescind Resolution No. 19-3.4 as well as approve a change in the building permit fee structure fee as proposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

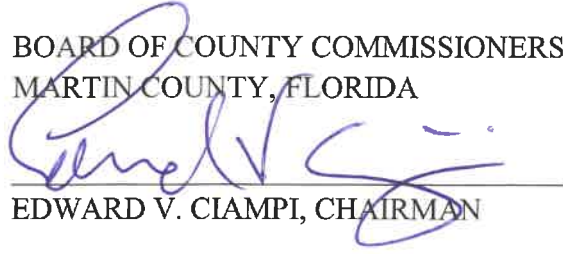
1. Resolution Number 19-3.4 is hereby rescinded.
2. In addition to the fees set forth in Resolution No. 02-7.33, the building permit reinspection fee is hereby increased to one hundred dollars (\$100) for the first reinspection, to two hundred (\$200) for the second and third reinspection, and to four hundred dollars (\$400) for each reinspection thereafter.
3. In addition to the fees set forth in Resolution No. 02-7.33, there is hereby established a building permit revision fee of fifty dollars (\$50) per page for each page submitted after the second submittal. There shall be no charge for the second submittal provided to address changes required pursuant to the first review. However, the permit revision fee shall be applicable to revisions submitted after the second submittal.
4. All terms and conditions of Resolution No. 02-7.33 which are not specifically amended or revised by this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
5. The change in the building permit fee structure shall become effective on November 1, 2019.
