We The people, on behalf of the citizens of Martin County, issue this declaration of rights and acknowledge the Sovereign God, the Creator, who gave unalienable rights to man, which is recognized by the U.S. and State Constitution. These rights are not to be violated by or from anyone or by law. A self-governed people have power vested to themselves and delegate certain powers and authority to government.

Liberty originates with individual sovereignty. That sovereignty begins with our personhood. No governing authority has any right to override individual sovereignty over our personhood, our labor, our earnings, or our property. The responsibility of government is to protect and ensure that liberty for every resident of its territory.

Emergency Powers, lockdowns, restrictions on citizens/businesses, masking mandates, and policies that have been enacted, past and present, are not in line with the U.S. Constitution, nor our Bill of Rights. 16

American Jurisprudence 2d, section 98 states, "While an emergency can not create power, no emergency justifies the violation of any of the provisions of the US and State Constitution." You all are acting outside of your "oath of office, the authority of your office and do not have authority to restrict the people of Martin County or mandate anything.

We are here to submit the following declaration:

Section 1. **Basic Rights** - All men are by nature equally free and independent and have certain inherent rights, of which, when they come together as a society, will not allow government or law to interfere with the enjoyment of life and liberty, with the means of acquiring and possessing property, and pursuing and obtaining happiness and safety. People are responsible for their own health, goods, means of production, education, and families. Government has no authority to interfere with these.

Section 2. **Political Authority** – All governing authority is vested in the people and they are the ones to delegate that power; governments and it's authorities are civil servants to them. Nevertheless, no political authority,

no group of the people, no emergency declaration, no state law, county, or civil law will be justified to remove or restrain the natural basic rights of the people. A free people cannot have representatives who seek to remove their rights.

The Martin County Board of County Commissioners is in violation of **18 U.S. Code 242, DEPREVATION OF RIGHTS.** "Whoever under color of any law, statute, ordinance, regulation, or custom, willfully subjects any person in any State to the deprivation of any right or privileges protected by the Constitution, shall be shall be fined under this title or imprisoned https://uscode.house.gov/view.xhtml?req=deprivation+of+rights+under+color+of+law&f=treesort&num=1&edition=prelim

The Martin County Board of County is in violation of 18 U.S. Code 241 CONSPIRACY AGAINST RIGHTS. "If two or more people conspire to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate any person in any State, in the free exercise or enjoyment of any right or privilege secured to him by the Constitution or laws of the United States, they shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than ten years, or both.

Section 3. Religious Freedom -

There shall be no law or ordinance respecting the establishment of religion or prohibiting or penalizing the free exercise thereof.

Section 4. Right to bear arms. -

The right of the people to keep and bear arms in defense of themselves and others and of the lawful authority of the state shall not be infringed.

Section 5. Freedom of speech and press—

person may speak, write and publish sentiments on all subjects but shall be responsible for the abuse of that right. No law shall be passed to restrain or abridge the liberty of speech or of the press.

Section 6. Due process. -

No person shall be deprived of **life**, **liberty or property without due process of law**, or be twice put in jeopardy for the same offense, or be compelled in any criminal or civil matter to be a witness against oneself.

We, the people, have not allowed our liberties to be taken, and as such, have not been through "due process", nor have been taken into consideration in past meetings, even when truths are presented. We stand united, with our consciences under God, to declare the Emergency Orders, mandatory lock downs/restrictions on businesses and gatherings, and masking ordinances, to be a gross overreach of natural rights and a violation of the People at Large's Unalienable Rights.

We have patiently attended these meetings, repeatedly asking that you repeal these usurpations and violations. We have presented the will of the people to you. We have presented scientific facts on COVID-19, and have given you observations of our community's status as we have endured such violations. And to quote the Declaration of Independence, "Our repeated petitions have been answered only by repeated injury." Only one of you has been willing to bring forth the complaints of the people to the board, where the rest of you refused to address them.

Therefore, on behalf of We The People of Martin County, we submit this declaration to you today, and formally reject these overreaching ordinances, and the emergency abuses of power, and today declare them null and void! It is our right, and our duty, to throw off such government abuse, and provide new guards for the security of our Rights.



Taryn,

I wanted to share some information and thoughts that I have found on the CDC website that may be helpful when the board discusses the mask ordinance, special events and other considerations moving forward addressing COVID. Residents continue to ask for some metrics that give some blueprint guidelines as to how the community will move forward to mitigate the spread of COVID in our community. I found reading some of the guidance below in the link on the CDC website helpful: https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/community-mitigation.html#table1
Below are some of the highlights I extracted from reading the guidance: Table 1 in particular would be valuable if metrics could be applied. Our staff came up with an amazing set of guidelines to implement CARES funding and I have no doubt that developing a mitigation strategy based on transmission in our community is an achievable objective.

Goals

The goal of community mitigation in areas with local COVID-19 transmission is to slow its spread and to protect all individuals, especially those at <u>increased risk for severe illness</u>, while minimizing the negative impacts of these strategies. These strategies are used <u>to minimize morbidity and mortality of COVID-19</u> in societal sectors such as schools, workplaces, and healthcare organizations.

Implementation is based on:

- Emphasizing individual responsibility for implementing recommended personal-level actions
- Empowering <u>businesses</u>, <u>schools</u>, and <u>other settings</u> to implement appropriate actions
- Prioritizing settings that provide <u>critical infrastructure services</u>
- Minimizing disruptions to daily life to the extent possible and ensuring access to health care and other essential services.

Guiding principles

- Each community is unique. Appropriate mitigation strategies should be based on the best available data. Decision making will vary based on the level of community transmission and local circumstances. Refer to <u>Table 1</u>.
- The characteristics of the community and its population, health system and public health capacity, and the local capacity to implement strategies are important when determining community mitigation strategies. Refer to <u>Table 2</u>.
- As communities adjust mitigation strategies, they should ensure that the healthcare system capacity will not be exceeded. Precautions should be taken to protect <u>health</u> <u>care professionals</u> and other <u>critical infrastructure workers</u>. Communities need to assure <u>healthcare systems</u> have adequate staffing, a surplus of <u>inpatient and ICU beds</u>, and critical medical equipment and supplies such as <u>PPE</u>.
- As communities adjust mitigation strategies, they should ensure public health capacity will not be exceeded. Public health system capacity relies on detecting, testing, contact

tracing, and isolating those who are or might be sick, or have been exposed to known or suspected COVID-19 cases; it is important to stop broader community transmission and prevent communities from having to implement or strengthen further community mitigation efforts.

- Attention should be given to <u>people who are at higher risk for severe illness</u> when determining and adjusting community mitigation strategies.
- Certain settings and vulnerable populations in a community are at particularly high risk for transmission. This includes but is not limited to <u>congregate settings such as nursing</u> <u>homes and other long-term care facilities</u>, <u>correctional facilities</u>, and the <u>homeless</u> <u>population</u>.
- Mitigation strategies can be scaled up or down, depending on the evolving local situation, and what is feasible, practical, and legal in a jurisdiction. Any signs of a cluster of new cases or a reemergence of broader community transmission should result in a re-evaluation of community mitigation strategies and a decision on whether and how mitigation might need to change.
- Communities need to decide the level of risk that is acceptable and make informed choices about implementing mitigation plans accordingly.
