H.Babacck, Clerk Pomeroy. Also Commissioners Warfer Tilton and F.M.Powell who had not yet filed their commissions.

The Eond of Harley E. Sharpe as H. tary Public was received and approved.

On motion of Ommissioner Dunscombe, seconded by Commissioner Rells, William

H. Smith was appointed Supervisor of Roads at a calrry of One Hundred and ways a live Callans
per month and soven cents per mile when innoceding roads, which motion are duly carried.

On motion of Commissioner Eelis, seconded by Commissioner Densecube the salary of truck trivers was fixed at One Hundred and Twenty five dollars per month.

A nestica was duly made, seconded and carried that the Supervisor of reads make an inspection trip on the road to Lake Okeechobse by Indian Town in connection with the repair of the road and bridges thereon with instructions to act.

The following road having been duly extersised according to law, in Palm Beach County, was declared a public county road by this Ecard;

Beginning at a point in the center of the County road running North and south through Section Seventeen, Township Thirty nine south, Range Forty one East, midway between the northwest and the south west corners of Lot two, Section Seventeen, Township thirty nine, South of Range Forty one, East thence cost through the center of each lot two, thence East through the senter of Lot One, Section seventeen, For shap Thirty nine, south of Range Forty one East to the centern boundary of said Lot one, a distance altogether of one buff mile work or land. The Manager of the Mixic Park Subdivision appeared before the Board potitioning for a railway processing. On motion of Commissioner Fells, rescaled by Carroll Danacombe, the Potral atterney was instructed to take up this matter with the Railrown Company.

On motion of Considerioner Dunacomb® seconded by Commissioner Rells, the city of StWWX the requested to fulfill its promise to give the old School house property to the County and to issue deed for same without any reversion provise. The motion was carried unanimously.

W. H. Roct was appointed County Surveyor at a colary of One dollar per year, this being the result of a motion by Corresponer Dunscombe, seconded by Commissioner Eelis.

The Chairman appointed Commissioners Dunsoombe, Eells and Tilton a Commisses to interview the local banks in regard to buying Fifty Thousand Dollars worth of Time warrants to be issued by Martin County.

The Gerk was instructed to write Superintendent Slitch of the State Prison Fare, of Rel or Fla. concerning cages for prisoners.
