SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR RESIDENTIAL AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS ON

SEXUAL OFFENDERS AND SEXUAL PREDATORS

Attached is the revised-proposed ordinance in connection with the above-captioned matter. There are two revisions:

- 1. The County Attorney's Office revised the definition of "conviction" and "convicted" in Section 111.152.4. to be more comprehensive and specific, specifically: (1) adding to "plea of guilty" those pleas made in exchange for an imposition or execution of sentence and adding a comprehensive list of qualifying sanctions imposed for a guilty plea; and (2) including convictions from tribal jurisdictions.
- 2. At the request of the Martin County Sheriff's Office, the time requirement in the definition of "permanent residence" in Section 111.152.8. was changed from 14 consecutive days to 3 consecutive days.
