REGARDING AUTHORIZING PERMISSION TO APPLY FOR A SMALL COUNTY OUTREACH PROGRAM (SCOP) GRANT BETWEEN MARTIN COUNTY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE SW KANSAS AVENUE RESURFACING AND ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION (FROM 100 FT. SOUTH OF CAMP VALOR, LLC TO SW KANNER HIGHWAY) PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of County Commissioners has made the following determinations of facts:

- 1. Martin County Board of County Commissioners will request funding assistance by the Department for the SW Kansas Avenue Resurfacing and Roadway Construction (from 100 ft. south of Camp Valor, LLC to SW Kanner Highway) project which provides for joint responsibilities of the Department and the County and to deliver such Application to the Department.
- 2. Martin County Board of County Commissioners has legal ownership of all designated Right of Way within the project limits of SW Kansas Avenue (from 100 ft. south of Camp Valor, LLC to SW Kanner Highway).
- 3. The Board has determined that it is appropriate to enter into an Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation and will commit to local match funding of the project.

The Board hereby authorizes the Director of the Martin County Public Works Department, or designee, to sign and deliver to the Florida Department of Transportation the Small County Outreach Program Application request for funding assistance by the Department for the SW Kansas Avenue Resurfacing and Roadway Construction (from 100 ft. south of Camp Valor, LLC to SW Kanner Highway) Project.
