**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE REDUCTION OF THE
MAXIMUM SPEED ON SW LOCKS ROAD WEST OF SW 18TH AVENUE**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Sec. 316.008(b), Fla. Stat., this Board is authorized to regulate the streets, highways, and bridges within its jurisdiction, including regulating traffic by means of official traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed The County Engineer's recommendation and has determined that establishing a maximum speed of 30 MPH on SW Locks Road west of SW 18th Avenue is appropriate and is in the best interest of the Citizens of Martin County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County (Board), Florida that:

- A. The Board repeals all prior resolutions related to the speed limits on the portion of SW Locks Road lying west of SW 18th Avenue; and
- B. The Board hereby establishes a maximum speed of 30 MPH on the portion of SW Locks Road lying west of SW 18th Avenue; and
- C. The Board hereby directs the Public Works Department to notify the Martin County Sheriff's Office of this Resolution.
