**A RESOLUTION FOR AN APPLICATION FOR FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF STATE  
DIVISION OF HISTORICAL RESOURCES SPECIAL CATEGORY GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Martin County Board of County Commissioners is interested in carrying out the described projects for the enjoyment of the citizenry on Martin County and the State of Florida:

**Project Title:** Roof replacement on the North and South Buildings at the House of Refuge complex.

**Total Estimated Cost:** up to \$216,037

**Brief description of Project:** Remove and replace existing roofs, gutters, and chimney (south building only) on north and south buildings, haul away all debris, install new historically accurate materials to protect against weather and natural elements, and restore the building to maintain its physical integrity.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that the project described above be authorized,

**AND**, be it further resolved that the Assistant County Administrator is authorized to make application to the Florida Department of State Division of Historical Resources in the amount of \$108,019 on behalf of said Martin County Board of County Commissioners,

**AND**, be it further resolved by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that it certifies to the following;

1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in the Division of Historical Resources Grant Agreement.
2. That it has the ability and intention to finance the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said Martin County Board of County Commissioners for public use.
3. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with the statutes relating to accessibility by handicapped persons as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.

4. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.
