# SUMMARY OF CHANGES

- Article 1
  - Establish 25 MPH as the minimum speed limit
  - Repeal Chapter 25 – Cable Communications
- Article 2
  - Require permits in County rights-of-way
    - Permanent improvement or facility
    - Road opening
- Article 3
  - Eliminate conflict with statutes (assessable paving)
  - Prohibit obstructions of County rights-of-way

# ARTICLE 2

## PERMITS IN RIGHTS-OF-WAY

- Application fee
- Application fee not applicable if applicant is:
  - regulated by Florida Public Services Commission;
  - regulated by Federal Communications Commission; or
  - a publicly owned utility.

# ARTICLE 2

## PERMITS IN RIGHTS-OF-WAY

- Application
  - Engineered plan
  - Roadway or sidewalk maintenance of traffic plan(s)
  - Cost estimate
  - Security
  - Schedule
  - Insurance

# ARTICLE 2

## PERMITS IN RIGHTS-OF-WAY

- Application review by County Engineer
- Coordination with other activities
- Open roads added to inventory
  - By new or future plat or within existing right-of-way
  - Semi-annual Board Resolutions
- Appeal of final action

# ARTICLE 3

## OBSTRUCTIONS OF RIGHTS-OF-WAY

- Obstructions Prohibited
  - Unlawful
  - Acceptable with permit and agreement
- Violations handled through Code Enforcement
  - Remove
  - Request a permit and execute an agreement
  - Request abandonment

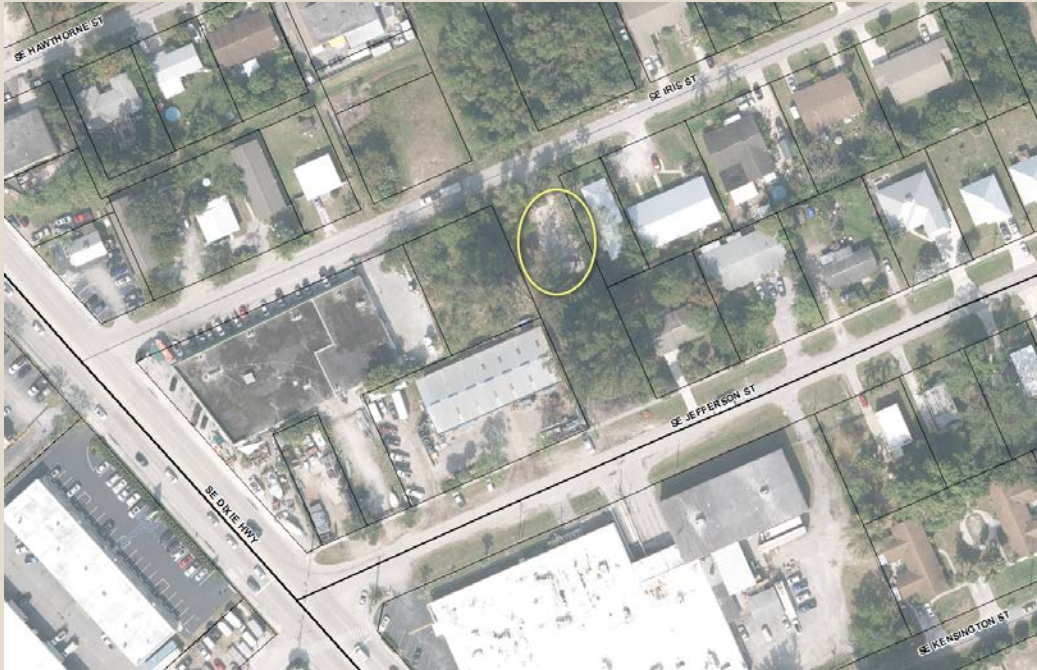

- Golden Gate – SE Camino Avenue

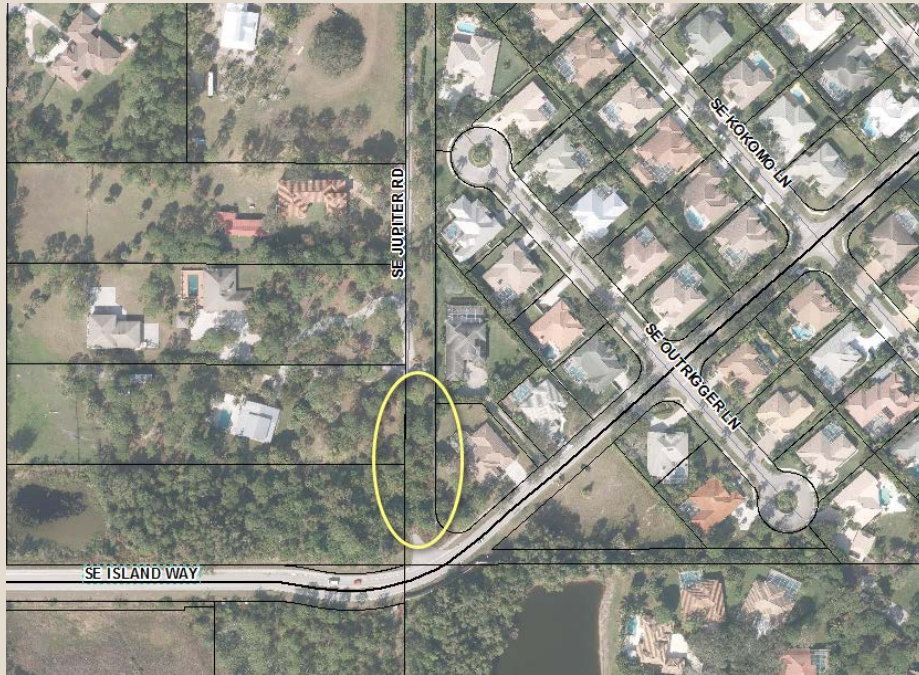

- Port Salerno – SE Isabelita Avenue

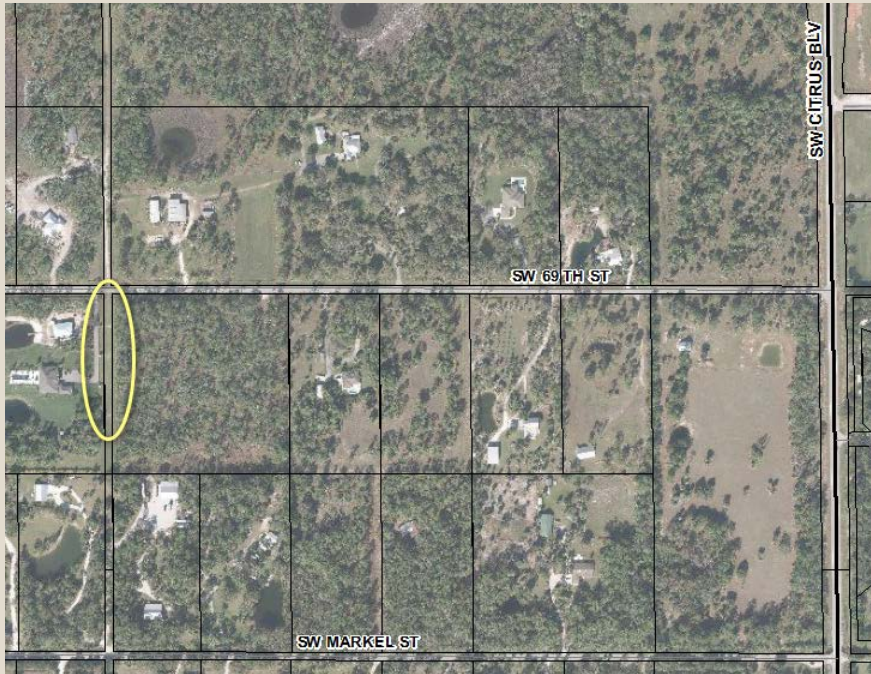

# ARTICLE 3

## OBSTRUCTIONS OF RIGHTS-OF-WAY

- Potential for significant fiscal impacts
  - Increase in code investigation and enforcement cases
  - New right-of-way maintenance responsibilities
  - Development of County-wide stormwater management plan to prioritize use of unopened rights-of-way
- Recommendation: Move adoption of the Ordinance as presented.
- Alternate recommendation: Move adoption of the Ordinance with the removal of Article 3, Obstructions.
