About the Martin MPO

İ

 Formed in 1993, the MPO decides how State and Federal funds available for transportation improvements in Martin County will be spent in the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Work Program.





 The MPO Board is composed of four County Commissioners, two Commissioners from the City of Stuart, one Commissioner from the Town of Sewall's Point, and one from the Village of Indiantown.







Advisory Committees

- The MPO's advisory committees were formed to review and make recommendations on the issues that come before the MPO Policy Board.
- The MPO Committees:
 - Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC)
 - Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)
 - Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC)
 - Local Coordinating Board (LCB) for the Transportation Disadvantaged










Product Requirements

- Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)
 - o 20 Year Plan
 - Update every five years
- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
 - Five-Year Program
 - Must be updated annually.
- Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)
 - Two-Year Work Program
 - Must be updated bi-annually
- All in cooperation with FDOT







MPO Cyclical Process












Fitting It All Together










What is a Long Range Transportation Plan?

- A Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is a blueprint to guide transportation investments in a community over a period of 20 to 25 year.
- LRTP is required to be updated every five years.
- LRTP is required by law to receive Federal and State transportation dollars for implementing projects.
- Encourages a safe and efficient transportation system that will serve the people of Martin County.
