GOLDEN GATE



Golden Gate Pathway

- We have been awarded the Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant!
- Next step is engineering, permitting, etc.

Dixie Highway Improvements (from Jefferson Street to Indian Street)

- Internal stakeholder meeting was held in December
- Identified crosswalk and median locations



Septic to Sewer

- Development order issued in November for alternative compliance of the vacuum building
- · Construction of the vacuum building has begun

Gomez Affordable Housing


- Road Opening Permit approved by the BOCC.
- Utility Plans in review by South Martin Regional Utilities.
- Construction Plans are expected to be ready for bid by February 2020.

Pettway Street Traffic Calming

 Construction of 4 speed tables, 2 crosswalks, sidewalk improvements, and roadway resurfacing was completed in November of 2019.

Bridge Road Main Street

- The contractor is working on the first phase of the project between Hercules Ave and Lares Ave on Bridge Road.
- Monthly Community-Merchant Project Update Meetings were held at the Hobe Sound Chamber of Commerce.
- Final Completion is estimated for Q4 2020.





JENSEN BEACH


Infill Sewer

 Church Street, Cherry Terrace, and Mango Terrace now have access to Martin County Water & Sewer. This project included the resurfacing of Mango Terrace and is complete.

Church Street Parking Improvements

- Completed construction drawings are expected by February 2020.
- Florida Power and Light is finalizing their plans for the undergrounding of the electric service. These plans are expected to be completed by the end of January 2020.

cipple Eco-Art Project

- The structural engineer designed the art pieces.
- Submitted BMAP credits to DEP.
- DEP gave approval of the 2nd grant.

Mapp Road Town Center

- Staff reviewed and commented on 100% engineer plans from Captec Engineering.
- Presented the final plans to the NAC.
- Giangrande Engineering began engineering the design for the plaza/patio area.
- Public Works to design and construct sidewalk around Fire Station STA.

Charlie Leighton Park

- Requested engineer design from Giangrande Engineering.
- Applied for a Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program Grant.

Parking Innovations (Park Drive)


 30% conceptual design is complete, and currently evaluating stormwater/water quality treatment options.

Safe Routes to School (SRTS)

 Martin County Capital Projects presented the designs and timeline of the project to the Port Salerno NAC in December.

Water Installation

• E 43rd Street extension is complete, and the lone resident who was without water is now connected!





RIO

Creative Placemaking

 Received NAC approval to enhance 3 existing benches along Dixie Hwy with new mosaic art benches; Received proposal from CHI Preservation Pro's.

Sewer Extensions

• Working with Utilities on a new 3 phase sewer project concept with grinder/pump stations; started working on design.

Sidewalk Connections

 New sidewalk proposal received for installation in the neighborhood North of Dixie Hwy and East and West of Martin.

Rio Stormwater/Flood Control

- Working with property owner to sign a drainage easement to connect Kubin Ave to the rear ditch.
- Project being designed and constructed in-house with the assistance of Public Works.
- Designed a few options for plantings and materials to workshop with the NAC on January 23

Property Acquisition

- · Working with property owners for acquisition.
- Signed contract for purchasing 1166 NE Charlotte Street and scheduled closing.














CRA WIDE







- CRA staff volunteered for the United Way White Doves holiday event.








1ST QUARTER CRA PERMIT TOTALS






1ST QUARTER CRA PERMIT VALUES
