**AND,** be it further resolved by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that it certifies to the following;

- 1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in the FBIP Grant Agreement.
- 2. That it has the ability and intention to finance the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said Martin County Board of County Commissioners for public use.
- 3. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with the statutes relating to accessibility by handicapped persons as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.
- 4. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.
