A Proclamation

**Declaring Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup Week
in Martin County, Florida**

- Whereas,** the 13th Annual Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup will be held on Saturday, July 25, 2020; and
- Whereas,** over 1,000 volunteers will participate in cleaning up the waterways of Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River counties; and
- Whereas,** the Marine Industries Association of the Treasure Coast and the Florida Inland Navigation District are taking the lead in this effort, along with other sponsors including the Martin County Board of County Commissioners; and
- Whereas,** the sustainability of our waterways is dependent upon efforts such as this that contribute to maintaining the health and beauty of our waterways so future generations may also appreciate and enjoy them; and
- Whereas,** since this clean up began, over 87.2 tons of trash from approximately 125 miles of waterways have been collected along the Treasure Coast.

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed by the Martin County Board of County Commissioners that July 19-25, 2020 is Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup Week in Martin County. Further, the board encourages residents to participate in this important event and commends the sponsors and volunteers whose contributions to this effort are so important to its success.
