BENEFITS OF THE NEW AGREEMENT

- ▶ Waste Management, Inc., of Florida (WMIF) will increase their fleet thereby adding addition routes that will reduce the pickup times during the day, improve overall operations and improve customer service.
- ▶ Transition to single stream recycling which uses 65-gallon wheeled carts that will be picked-up by an automated system on the recycling truck.
- ▶ Conversion of the majority of their fleet to run on compressed natural gas (CNG) which will lower pollution emissions and carbon footprint.



HIGHLIGHTS OF NEW AGREEMENT

- ▶ On the commencement date of October 1, 2021, no vehicles can be more than ten (10) years old.
- ▶ 75% of new front-line vehicles must be in service by December 31, 2021.
- ▶ All collection vehicles must be model year 2020 or newer on October 1, 2022.
- ▶ Recycling carts will be procured and distributed before the commencement date.
- ▶ The initial 3% fixed rate Consumer Price Index for Water-Sewer-Trash will be replaced and applied each year with a provision for a floor of 2% and a ceiling of 5%.
- ▶ Recognition of recycling cart restrictions in certain communities and allowing for a reduction in the quantity of 65-gallon containers, administrative procedure change for a commercial right sizing program and other administrative and reporting requirements that improved the contract.
- ▶ Funding from the contractor will be dedicated to public notices and educational services. This was currently funded at \$25,000 annually and applied to specific applications. Increased to \$40,000 annually and expanding the list of compliant recipients to community groups and organizations with a focus on litter control, environmental improvements and other value-added activities.
