# 7. PROJECTS

Kevin Abbate, Parks and Recreation Director, gave updates on the following projects:

# A. Spending

Kevin Abbate gave a detailed overview of how the Parks and Recreation Department spends its funds, what it budgets for, and how it decides to spend its funds and prioritize projects. He also explained the Fixed Asset Replacement Budget and Capital Improvement Plan.

# B. Phipps Park

Kevin continued by detailing where the campground is in terms of construction. He noted that all current electric sites are booked for the season and there is a large waiting list. All electric sites both new and existing will also be 50-amp sites.

### C. Stuart Beach

Kevin continued by describing what is happening at Stuart Beach in terms of the parking lot expansion, the construction of the Seaside Café. He noted that the café is slated to open in March.

### D. Sailfish Sands Golf Course

Kevin mentioned that the reversible nine golf course will open on January 1, 2021. He noted that parking lot construction started last Friday, and the clubhouse and pro shop are in permitting currently. Discussion.

### E. IRSP Seawall Repair

Kevin spoke regarding a grant for the repair of the seawall and that the Parks and Recreation Department just awarded a bid for the repair that was a couple hundred thousand dollars under what was expected.

# F. Jensen Beach Mooring Field

Kevin mentioned that it should be open for business within the next ten days and that the harbor master has been hired.

### G. Sandsprit Park Boat Ramp Renovation

Kevin mentioned that it is out for permits currently and more grants are being sought to cover the expenses of the repairs.

### H. Pineapple Park Playground/Master Plan

Kevin Abbate mentioned that they are wrapping up the design of the roof and they are finalizing the choice of the playground type. He also noted that they are in the beginning stages of the Pineapple Park Master Plan where the construction will be finished, and fields possibly added.

### I. Charlie Leighton Park Improvements

Kevin mentioned that they are at 60% design plans for the park currently and that a new field will be built at Citrus Grove Park for the displaced teams to use.

### J. Chastain Beach Restroom

Kevin continued the updates by noting that the restrooms had been destroyed by a recent hurricane and talks have taken place as to whether they should be replaced or not.

# K. Indian Riverside Park/Parking Lot Expansion/Langford Pavilion First Floor Renovation

Kevin noted that the U.S. Sailing Center has a grant to cover building a new parking lot that the Sailing Center can use. He continued by mentioning that the first floor of the Francis Langford Dockside Pavilion will be converted into a bride and groom room, an office space, and a gathering place for events.
