## Agenda Item: 19-0611 MAPP RD TOWN CENTER STREETSCAPE

## Agenda Item: 19-0613 OLD PALM CITY NEIGHBORHOOD RESTORATION

Jordan Pastorius, Sr. Project Manager for the Office of Community Development, gave an overview of the project through a slide presentation and map. Public Works Department will be working on the drainage swales and repaving the neighborhood streets in conjunction with the Utilities Septic to Sewer Project. We need approximately 16 properties to provide drainage easements and so far, we have 8 that have agreed to the easement.

#### COMMENT

- PUBLIC Charlie Bingham, OPC resident received a letter from FPL indicating that they will be undergrounding utilities on 32<sup>nd</sup> St. Chuck Smith received one as well and will forward to staff for clarification.
- MEMBERS R. Sentell is the road bed still intact? Joe Capra of CAPTEC Engineering responded with the progress on Mapp Rd. The road beds are still intact.
  - J. Landrum with all of our drainage issues, can the swales be maintained?
  - J. Pastorius The MC Public Works Department most likely has maintenance schedule for mowing and picking up debris for swales that are on county property, in Rights of Way, or within easements. I will follow up. The drainage easements should help. J. Capra we have proposed improvements to the swales with new piping, etc. Once the work is completed, the county will maintain them.
  - D. Legler is the Mapp Road Plaza design being completed by TIF and the Neighborhood Restoration project being paid by Public Works? J. Pastorius yes, but the Plaza will also receive funds from the Rotary Club.
  - R. Sentell two dumpsters have suddenly appeared by my business. Does this have anything to do with the Blasko house? J. Pastorius yes, Rick Mancil will be moving the house to his property.

## WHO MUST FILE FORM 8B

This form is for use by any person serving at the county, city, or other local level of government on an appointed or elected board, council, commission, authority, or committee, it applies to members of advisory and non-advisory bodies who are presented with a voting conflict of interest under Section 112.3143, Florida Statutes.

Your responsibilities under the law when faced with voting on a measure in which you have a conflict of interest will vary greatly depending on whether you hold an elective or appointive position. For this reason, please pay close attention to the instructions on this form before completing and filling the form.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 112.3143, FLORIDA STATUTES

A person holding elective or appointive county, municipal, or other local public office MUST ABSTAIN from voting on a measure which would inure to his or her special private gain or loss. Each elected or appointed local officer also MUST ABSTAIN from knowingly voting on a measure which would inure to the special gain or loss of a principal (other than a government agency) by whom he or she is retained (including the parent, subsidiary, or sibling organization of a principal by which he or she is retained); to the special private gain or loss of a relative; or to the special private gain or loss of a business associate. Commissioners of community redevalopment agencies (CRAs) under Sec. 163.356 or 183.357, F.S., and officers of independent special tax districts elected on a one-agre, one-vote basis are not prohibited from voting in that capacity.

For purposes of this law, a "relative" includes only the officer's father, mother, son, daughter, husband, wife, brother, sister, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, and daughter-in-law. A "business associate" means any person or entity engaged in or carrying on a business enterprise with the officer as a partner, joint venturer, coowner of property, or corporate shareholder (where the shares of the corporation are not listed on any national or regional stock exchange).

#### **ELECTED OFFICERS:**

in addition to abstaining from voting in the situations described above, you must disclose the conflict:

PRIOR TO THE VOTE BEING TAKEN by publicly stating to the assembly the nature of your interest in the measure on which you are abstaining from voting; and

WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER THE VOTE OCCURS by completing and filing this form with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who should incorporate the form in the minutes.

## **APPOINTED OFFICERS:**

Although you must abstain from voting in the situations described above, you are not prohibited by Section 112.3143 from otherwise participating in these matters. However, you must disclose the nature of the conflict before making any attempt to influence the decision, whether orally or in writing and whether made by you or at your direction.

IF YOU INTEND TO MAKE ANY ATTEMPT TO INFLUENCE THE DECISION PRIOR TO THE MEETING AT WHICH THE VOTE WILL BE TAKEN:

 You must complete and file this form (before making any attempt to influence the decision) with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who will incorporate the form in the minutes. (Continued on page 2)

## **APPOINTED OFFICERS (continued)**

- A copy of the form must be provided immediately to the other members of the agency.
- The form must be read publicly at the next meeting after the form is filed.

IF YOU MAKE NO ATTEMPT TO INFLUENCE THE DECISION EXCEPT BY DISCUSSION AT THE MEETING:

- You must disclose orally the nature of your conflict in the measure before participating.
- You must complete the form and file it within 15 days after the vote occurs with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who must incorporate the form in the minutes. A copy of the form must be provided immediately to the other members of the agency, and the form must be read publicly at the next meeting after the form is filed.
