Agenda Item: 20-0227, Safe Routes to School

Paul Bangs, Project Engineer with Martin County Public Works, presented the upcoming sidewalk connection project known as Safe Routes to School.

- P. Bangs the project will begin January 6, 2020 and be completed by May 6, 2020.
- B. Olsen Kingfish will connect on the east side of the street, not the west side correct?
- P. Bangs yes
- C. Josie are there any plans for installing railings, what about the conditions of existing sidewalks, are they being repaired and has lighting been evaluated?
- P. Bangs We will install railings according to code. Existing sidewalk repairs and lighting evaluations will not part of this project/grant.
- C. Winters Please address the picture you presented of the residence with parking spaces in front, are you taking away part of their parking space?
- A. Mendoza I live next door to this property and this is the first I have heard of this project and I have concerns. The sidewalk is cutting right into my driveway and I will not be able to park my three cars. Also, will you be removing the trees? Is this a done deal?
- P. Bangs We will be taking most of the trees, yes. We still have time to adjust if we need to.
- J. Taylor Can we wait to do this project later?
- P. Bangs No the grant has been issued by FDOT and must be completed on their timeframe.
- S. Kores We have the contact information and we will reach out to Ms. Mendoza to address her concerns.
